Ladies & Gentlemen,

Last planned report from HQDA is included below. Since that report:

- Approximately a company of Guardsmen from the DC NG arrived at the U.S. Capital and began integrating with federal law enforcement.
- Planning is underway to add additional Guardsmen to the defensive posture around the U.S. Capital in support of the U.S. Capital Police.
- ARNG began coordination for out of state troops to augment the DC NG through the end of the month in accordance with SECDEF direction. Pending validated requests for assistance, starting tomorrow, ARNG could provide several thousand Soldiers from multiple states through the end of January.
- HQDA staff is coordinating with Federal partners to facilitate procurement and assembly of additional fencing vicinity the U.S. Capital.

Following this report the Army Operations Center will resume normal CCIR reporting to Army Senior Leaders barring additional changes to the environment in D.C.
