This is the final response to your January 11, 2021, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS). You are seeking

1. All communications (including emails, email attachments, complete email chains, text messages (or messages on similar applications such as Signal or WhatsApp) and calendar invitations) sent or received by the officials listed below regarding events at the U.S. Capitol, U.S. National Mall, or surrounding grounds in Washington D.C. on January 6, 2021, including but not limited to the potential or actual deployment of law enforcement officers and/or National Guard troops, requests for assistance from members of Congress or Congressional staff, protests or armed activity at the Capitol, President Trump's rally, or concerns about security.
2. All orders, directives, protocols, or guidance prepared, written, approved, or signed by the officials listed below, regarding events at the U.S. Capitol, U.S. National Mall, or surrounding grounds in Washington D.C. on January 6, 2021, including but not limited to the potential or actual deployment of law enforcement officers and/or National Guard troops, requests for assistance from members of Congress or Congressional staff, protests or armed activity at the Capitol, President Trump's rally, or concerns about security.

To provide you with the greatest degree of access authorized by law, DHS has considered your request under both the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, and the Privacy Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552a. In this case, a search of DHS's Federal Protective Service (FPS) for documents responsive to your request produced a total of 95 pages. Two pages originated with United States Capitol Police, and three

pages originated with the District of Columbia Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency's National Capital Region Threat Intelligence Consortium and are referred to those agencies for review and direct response to you.

Following review, DHS has determined that four pages are released in full, nine pages are completely withheld in their entirety, and 81 pages are partially releasable pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(5), (b)(6), (b)(7)(A), (b)(7)(C), (b)(7)(E), and (b)(7)(F), FOIA Exemptions 5, 6, 7A, 7C, 7E, and 7F.

Enclosed are 81 pages with certain information withheld as described below:

FOIA Exemption 5 protects from disclosure those inter- or intra-agency documents that are normally privileged in the civil discovery context. The three most frequently invoked privileges are the deliberative process privilege, the attorney work-product privilege, and the attorney-client privilege. After carefully reviewing the responsive documents, I have determined that portions of the responsive documents qualify for protection under the

- **Deliberative Process Privilege**

The deliberative process privilege protects the integrity of the deliberative or decision-making processes within the agency by exempting from mandatory disclosure opinions, conclusions, and recommendations included within inter-agency or intra-agency memoranda or letters. The release of this internal information would discourage the expression of candid opinions and inhibit the free and frank exchange of information among agency personnel.

FOIA Exemption 6 exempts from disclosure personnel or medical files and similar files the release of which would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. This requires a balancing of the public's right to disclosure against the individual's right to privacy. The privacy interests of the individuals in the records you have requested outweigh any minimal public interest in disclosure of the information. Any private interest you may have in that information does not factor into the aforementioned balancing test.

FOIA Exemption 7(A) protects from disclosure records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, the release of which could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings. I have determined that the information you are seeking relates to an ongoing criminal law enforcement investigation. Therefore, I am withholding all records, documents, and/or other material, which if disclosed prior to completion, could reasonably be expected to interfere with law enforcement proceedings and final agency actions related to those proceedings. Please be advised that once all pending matters are resolved and FOIA Exemption 7(A) is no longer applicable, there may be other exemptions which could protect certain information from disclosure, such as FOIA Exemptions (2), 7(C), 7(D), and 7(E).

FOIA Exemption 7(C) protects records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes that could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. This exemption takes particular note of the strong interests of individuals, whether they are suspects, witnesses, or investigators, in not being unwarrantably associated with alleged criminal activity. That interest extends to persons who are not only the subjects of the investigation, but those who may have their privacy invaded by having their identities and information about them revealed in connection with an investigation. Based upon the traditional recognition of strong privacy interest in law enforcement records, categorical withholding of information that identifies third parties in law enforcement records is ordinarily appropriate. As such, I have determined that the privacy interest in the identities of individuals in the records you have requested clearly outweigh any minimal public interest in disclosure of the information. Please note that any private interest you may have in that information does not factor into this determination.

FOIA Exemption 7(E) protects records compiled for law enforcement purposes, the release of which would disclose techniques and/or procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law.

FOIA Exemption 7(F) permits the government to withhold all information about any individual when disclosure of information about him could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any individual. This exemption also protects physical security at critical infrastructure sites.

While an adequate search was conducted, you have the right to appeal the above withholding determination. Should you wish to do so, you must send your appeal and a copy of this letter, within 90 days of the date of this letter, to: Privacy Office, Attn: FOIA Appeals, U.S. Department of Homeland Security, 2707 Martin Luther King Avenue SE, Mail Stop 0655, Washington, D.C. 20528-0655, following the procedures outlined in the DHS FOIA regulations at 6 C.F.R. Part 5 § 5.8. Your envelope and letter should be marked "FOIA Appeal." Copies of the FOIA and DHS FOIA regulations are available at www.dhs.gov/foia.

Provisions of the FOIA allow DHS to recover part of the cost of complying with your request. In this instance, because the cost is below the \$25.00 minimum, there is no charge.

Sir,

Last night was relatively peaceful with arrests for possession of weapon (x4) around Freedom Plaza and disorderly around BLM Plaza. Currently, we have groups of people moving towards The Ellipse for upcoming activities today with POTUS speaking at 1100hrs.

This morning we are tracking three major rallies:

0000-1630: NPS Permit 21-0278: Women For America First will hold a rally on the Ellipse. President Trump is scheduled to speak at this event around 1100 hours. The permit application states that 20,000 people will attend this event. It is expected that a portion of this group will march to the U.S. Capitol prior to 1300 hrs.

0900-1300: NPS Permit Number Not Available: #Go Right/March 4 Trump/ (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) will meet at Columbus Circle and rally until 1300 hours at which time they will march to the U.S. Capitol via an unknown route. 500 individuals are estimated to attend this event based on the NPS Permit Application.

1200-1800: NPS Permit 21-0271: The Silent Majority group will hold a rally on the National Mall at 13th Street. Between 250-500 individuals are permitted for this event.

Joint Session Congress will commence at 1300hrs therefore we expect large groups at US Capitol and US Supreme Court today, also.





Quick update, attached is a bulletin (First Amendment Protected Activities) sent out to all agency's security managers, GSA, and FSC Chair/DO for their situational awareness for tomorrow's events. Additionally, I have spoken with GSA (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) specifically reference the Federal Triangle area and preparations. At this time, public access to the parking garage will be allowed, however with all the road closures beginning this morning at 0600hrs and through Wednesday morning, the parking garage will not be a major concern for FPS. The numbers of protesters varies based on which news channel is reporting, but (b)(7)(E) has the number at approximately 6,000 at this time.

There are numerous scheduled rallies/protests beginning tomorrow (see attached Demonstrations Report), which R11 will monitor. The areas of concern regarding rallies is captured in the bulletin, while these events may not directly correlate with FPS protected facilities, the potential for a higher rate of vehicular and pedestrian traffic, road and street closures are likely to occur throughout NCR:






