Dear Requester:

This is the fifth interim response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, originally received by the United States Secret Service (Secret Service) on January 12, 2021, for information pertaining to:

1. All communications (including emails, email attachments, complete email chains, text messages (or messages on similar applications such as Signal or WhatsApp) and calendar invitations) sent or received by the officials listed below regarding events at the U.S. Capitol, U.S. National Mall, or surrounding grounds in Washington D.C. on January 6, 2021, including but not limited to the potential or actual deployment of law enforcement officers and/or National Guard troops, requests for assistance from members of Congress or Congressional staff, protests or armed activity at the Capitol, President Trump's rally, or concerns about security.

Please note that American Oversight does not seek, and that this request specifically excludes, the initial mailing of news clips or other mass-distribution emails. However, subsequent communications forwarding such emails are responsive to this request. In other words, for example, if a specified official received a mass-distribution news clip email referencing protests or violent activity at the Capitol, that initial email would not be responsive to this request. However, if a specified official forwarded that email to another individual with his own commentary, that subsequent message would be responsive to this request and should be produced.

2. All orders, directives, protocols, or guidance prepared, written, approved, or signed by the officials listed below, regarding events at the U.S. Capitol, U.S. National Mall, or surrounding grounds in Washington D.C. on January 6, 2021, including but not limited to

the potential or actual deployment of law enforcement officers and/or National Guard troops, requests for assistance from members of Congress or Congressional staff, protests or armed activity at the Capitol, President Trump's rally, or concerns about security.

**FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT
SUBSECTIONS OF TITLE 5, UNITED STATES CODE, SECTION 552**

Provisions of the Freedom of Information Act do not apply to matters that are:

- (b) (1) (A) specifically authorized under criteria established by an Executive Order to be kept Secret in the interest of national defense or foreign policy; and (B) are in fact properly classified pursuant to such Executive Order;
- (b) (2) related solely to the internal personnel rules and practices of any agency;
- (b) (3) specifically exempted from disclosure by statute (other than section 552b of this title), if that statute: (A)(i) requires that the matters be withheld from the public in such a manner as to leave no discretion on the issue, or (ii) establishes particular criteria for withholding or refers to particular types of matters to be withheld; and (B) is enacted after the date of enactment of the OPEN FOIA Act of 2009;

- (b) (7) records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that the information: (A) could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings; (B) would deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication; (C) could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy; (D) could reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of a confidential source, including a State, local, foreign agency or authority, or any private institution that furnished information on a confidential basis, and/or when records/information compiled by a criminal law enforcement authority in the course of a criminal investigation, or by an agency conducting a lawful national security intelligence investigation, information furnished by a confidential source; (E) would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law; (F) could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any individual;
- (b) (8) contained in or related to examination, operating, or condition reports prepared by, on behalf of, or for the use of an agency responsible for regulation or supervision of financial institutions; and
- (b) (9) geological and geophysical information and data, including maps, concerning wells.

Briefing Statement

Bureau: National Park Service

Issue: NPS Permit# 21-0278 – Women For America First

Program: WASO – Visitor and Resource Protection – United States Park Police

Key Points:

- The Women For America First will assemble on the Ellipse on January 6, 2021 for a First Amendment demonstration to protest the results of the 2020 elections.
- Expected attendance is around 5,000 participants.
- POTUS is expected to speak at the event at approximately 1100 hours.
- Previous similar First Amendment demonstrations have led to wide-spread violence in the downtown DC area.

Background:

On January 6, 2021, Congress will hold a joint session to formally certify the electoral votes from the 2020 election. It is expected that some members of Congress will object to the election results that the Biden-Harris ticket won the election. Numerous First Amendment demonstrations are expected in the downtown DC area to protest the results of this election. On November 14, 2020 and December 12, 2020, similar protests occurred. In both instances wide-spread violence occurred in the downtown DC area, perpetrated by both sides of the political spectrum.

Schedule of Events (January 6, 2021) (U//LES)

- 0500 hours: First wave of USPP personnel report for assignment.
- (b)(7)(E) USSS/USPP security sweeps begin.
- 0700 hours: Gates open to general public.
- 0900 hours: Rally begins.
- 1100 hours: POTUS arrival/POTUS remarks.
- TBD: POTUS departure.
- 1630 hours: Event concludes.

NPS Impact

- NPS areas impacted will include President's Park and the National Mall and Memorial Parks.
- NPS should expect higher than normal visitation with both pro and counter groups occupying NPS reservations.
- USPP, in coordination with the Metropolitan DC Police Department, will enact both no parking restrictions and road closures in the following areas on NPS jurisdiction:
 - Madison Drive between 3rd Street and 14th Street NW
 - Jefferson Drive between 3rd Street and 14th Street NW
 - Constitution Avenue between 15th Street and 18th Street NW
 - 15th Street between Independence Avenue SW and Constitution Avenue NW
 - 17th Street between Independence Avenue SW and Constitution Avenue NW


