Dear Requester:

This letter is a final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated January 11, 2021 for all call logs from January 6, 2021 from the officials specified below:

1. Major General William Walker, Commander, DC National Guard (DCNG)
2. Brigadier General (BG) Aaron Dean II, Adjutant General, DCNG
3. BG Mark Maldonado, Commander, DCNG

Your request was received by the National Guard Bureau (NGB) on January 11, 2021 and assigned case #J-21-0057. On July 9, 2021, August 4, 2021, and November 30, 2021 we provided interim responses to you through the Department of Justice for records responsive to your request. Our release to you on November 30, 2021 finalized the response regarding records from NGB.

A search conducted by knowledgeable staff with the DCNG revealed 12 pages responsive to your request. We are providing a final response to you through DoJ for items 1 through 3 of your request, as listed above. The records you have requested are being granted to you in part. After a thorough review of these documents, our office determined that portions of them are exempt from disclosure under the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(6) and (b)(7)(E).

Exemption (b)(6) protects personnel, medical, and similar files the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Under this exemption, I am withholding names of Department of Defense employees below the grade of General Officer and personal information on third parties.

Exemption (b)(7)(E) protects from disclosure those techniques and procedures for law/administrative enforcement investigations/prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement which could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law.


