Mr. Evers,

This letter responds to your 12 January 2021 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, Subject: FOIA FA-21-0009, requesting any analysis produced between December 23, 2020 through January 6, 2021, regarding the threat of protestors, militia groups, or domestic terrorists to the congressional certification of the 2020 election results on January 6, 2021.

We are writing to partially respond to your request. We have attached 2 attachments which are being released to you in part. Portions of these materials are being withheld under the following FOIA exemptions 3 and 7. Information that is prohibited from disclosure by another federal law. The documents if released in full, would reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of a confidential source and will disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions.

Withholding this information constitutes a partial denial of your request. This withholding is made on behalf of Major General Donna Martin, the Provost Marshal General.
