## **Man wanted in U.S. Capitol siege arrested in Florida**

*Located by Marion County Sheriff's Office and FBI Jacksonville*

*Jacksonville, FL* – On the afternoon of Thursday, January 14, 2021, Michael Curzio of Summerfield, Florida was taken into custody by the Marion County Sheriff's Office during a joint operation with the FBI Jacksonville Division, and in coordination with the FBI Washington Field Office.

Curzio was among the first individuals to be charged federally for his role in the riot and assault on the U.S. Capitol on January 6. The charges, announced by the U.S. Attorney's Office for the District of Columbia on January 7, included knowingly entering or remaining in any restricted building or grounds without lawful authority; or knowingly, with intent to impede government business or official functions, engaging in disorderly conduct on Capitol grounds; and violent entry and disorderly conduct on Capitol grounds (<https://www.justice.gov/opa/pr/thirteen-charged-federal-court-following-riot-united-states-capitol>.)

"The FBI respects the rights of individuals to peacefully exercise their First Amendment rights, but we will not tolerate those who seek to incite violence or wreak havoc on our established institutions," said Rachel L. Rojas, Special Agent in Charge of the FBI Jacksonville Division. "We will continue to hold accountable those who were responsible for last week's violent actions, and coordinate with our federal, state, and local partners to ensure safety in all North Florida communities in the future.

The FBI is grateful to our partners at the Marion County Sheriff's Office for their diligence and assistance in locating Michael Curzio, bringing us one step closer toward justice. 





I hope everyone had a great New Year! We thought that 2020 was a challenging year, but 2021 is starting out the same.

As you're all aware, the United States Capitol was breached Wednesday, January 6th. This criminal act resulted in multiple deaths, to include the death of Capital Police Officer Brian Sicknick, many injured law enforcement officers and citizens, significant property damage, theft, and disruption of the United States Congress.

The breach of the Capitol Building and subsequent criminal activities is the subject of an ongoing investigation conducted by the U.S. Capitol Police, the FBI, and numerous federal, State, and local law enforcement agencies. As part of our aggressive national effort to identify and locate all those involved in Wednesday's activities, I would like to request that you all please convey to your deputies, officers, and agents, that any information or leads regarding those involved be immediately relayed to the FBI for action. Many travelled from Florida to attend the planned protest, so they may have in their possession photos or other evidence critical towards potential prosecutions or at bare minimum deterring other planned events. We are making a very strong and concerted effort to identify all those involved, not only to apply justice, but also to disrupt very credible pending threats, that may target the upcoming Inauguration.

ADL is not aware of any credible threats of acts of violence that are slated to occur between January 12, 2021, and the President-elect's Inauguration on January 20, 2021. However, if the past is any indication, the combination of an extremist presence at rallies and events and the heated nature of online rhetoric suggests that violence is a possibility.
2. The second memo addresses ADL's Center on Extremism's insight regarding the upcoming scheduled event dubbed #J17, "Refuse to be Silenced," and "Tree of Liberty," to be held at state capitols nationwide.

## Joint Intelligence Bulletin Warns US Capitol Breach May Encourage Extremists

The [New York Times](#)   (1/13, Kanno-Youngs) reports that last week's breach of the Capitol will be a "significant driver of violence" for extremists who are targeting the inauguration, according to a joint intelligence bulletin issued jointly on Wednesday by the National Counterterrorism Center, the DOJ and DHS. The "boogaloo" movement "may exploit the aftermath of the Capitol breach by conducting attacks to destabilize and force a climactic conflict in the United States." The officials "wrote that extremist groups have viewed the breach of the Capitol as a success and have been galvanized by the death of Ashli Babbitt, a QAnon follower who was shot by the police as she tried to enter the heavily protected Speaker's Lobby, just outside the House chamber."

**US Governors Prepare For Continued Violence Against State Capitols.** The [Washington Post](#)   (1/13, Bailey, Craig) reports from Minneapolis, Minnesota, "The nation's governors, facing increasing threats to their capitols and little support or information from the federal government, said Wednesday that they are bracing for long-term danger from extremist groups who already have breached government buildings, damaged property and been linked to threats against state leaders and their families. 'It's going to take quite a while to turn back what's been started here,' said Minnesota Gov. Tim Walz (D), who has participated in joint calls in recent days with other Midwestern governors about the possibility of fresh violence in the aftermath of last week's riot at the U.S. Capitol and an FBI warning about armed far-right extremists gathering across the country this weekend."

**Experts Urge US Authorities To Enforce Laws Banning Unauthorized "Militias."** [USA Today](#)   (1/13, Carless) reports that "some legal experts are calling on authorities to enforce longstanding laws outlawing organized groups that act as citizen-run, unauthorized militias." Various federal and state laws "outlaw groups that engage in activities reserved for state agencies, including acting as law enforcement, training and drilling together, engaging in crowd control and making shows of force as armed groups at public gatherings." Still, "hundreds of armed groups, organized under the insignia of the Oath Keepers, the Three Percenters and others, do exactly that." The outlet adds, "Militias are groups of citizens called upon to aid their country in times of war or emergency," while these groups "have no legal authority whatsoever, and some are strongly anti-government."

## Missouri Authorities Capture Multiple Individuals After Resurrecting Most Wanted List

The [Columbian \(MS\) Progress](#)   (1/13, Ulmer) reports, "On January 8, the Department of Public Safety in coordination with the Mississippi Bureau of Investigation released a Most Wanted List with 10 individuals who were of high priority to be detained in Mississippi," and "since releasing the list, five of those individuals have already been apprehended." The Progress adds, "Commissioner of DPS Sean Tindell said it has been over 25 years since Mississippi has done a most wanted list. 'Back when it was done, of course, we didn't have social media and it was a much different landscape,' said Tindell. 'In looking at other states and knowing the power of social media we thought it would be a great opportunity to bring it back so that we could get this list of violent criminals and get their names out because they were either wanted by local law enforcement or they had absconded parole and were bad people that needed to be back in prison.'"

## US Traffic Deaths Skyrocket After Expiration Of COVID-19 Lockdowns

### Bath, England Considering Counter-Terrorism Measures

The [Denver Post](#)   (1/12, Nicholson) reports an analysis done by AAA Colorado has found that “the number of pedestrians killed annually on Colorado’s roadways has nearly doubled since 2009.” The Colorado increase “surpasses a 55% nationwide rise in pedestrian deaths over the same period, according to a news release.”

### Man Smashes New Zealand Parliament Building Doors

[CNN](#)   (1/13) reports, “A man smashed the glass front doors of New Zealand’s Parliament building with an axe early on Wednesday morning, according to authorities in the country.” CNN adds, “Police officers were called to the scene in the capital Wellington, and arrested the man without incident, a New Zealand police spokesperson said. ‘The man caused some damage to glass panels but did not attempt to enter the building,’ the spokesperson said.” According to CNN, “The 31-year-old man

appeared at the Wellington District Court Wednesday morning for intentional damage and possession of an offensive weapon, the spokesperson said. The motive for the attack is unclear and police declined to comment further, citing the ongoing court case.”

### Experts Say Threat Of Violence From Extremist Groups Unlikely To Fade

The [AP](#)   (1/13, Boone, Flaccus, Kunzelman) reports, “As rioters laid siege to the U.S. Capitol, the seat of American democracy became a melting pot of extremist groups: militia members, white supremacists, paramilitary organizations, anti-maskers and fanatical supporters of President Donald Trump, standing shoulder to shoulder in rage.” Experts “say it was the culmination of years of increasing radicalization and partisanship, combined with a growing fascination with paramilitary groups and a global pandemic,” and “warn that the armed insurrection that left five people dead and shook the country could be just the beginning.” As the FBI issues warnings about plans for armed protests across the country, “those who monitor online chatter say the threat of more violence by far-right fringe groups hasn’t abated.”

### Bath, England Considering Counter-Terrorism Measures

[BBC News](#)   (1/13) reports, “Measures backed by counter-terrorism police could see road access limited in a historic city centre to prevent vehicles being used as weapons.” BBC News adds, “Proposals for the centre of Bath also include removing parking and introducing moving bollards. Some 200 people have responded to a public consultation, with one residents’ association saying vulnerable people could be ‘trapped’. The council and police say the measures are proportionate to the threat.” According to BBC News, “Concrete barriers in Bath are already in place but could be replaced with static and moving bollards intended to fit with its Georgian character. Insp Martin Rowland, from counter terrorism police south west, said: ‘We know there is a national threat to the United Kingdom from terrorism and we know from past attacks that crowded places have been targeted. ‘We always balance the message around terrorism which is for people to be alert but not alarmed.’”

### **BJS RELEASES RACE AND ETHNICITY OF VIOLENT CRIME OFFENDERS AND ARRESTEES, 2018**

WASHINGTON — The Department of Justice’s Bureau of Justice Statistics today released *Race and Ethnicity of Violent Crime Offenders and Arrestees, 2018*. This report compares the FBI’s Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) Program data on incidents of nonfatal violent crime to data from BJS’s National Crime Victimization Survey (NCVS) to determine if arrest differences by race and ethnicity can be attributed to differences in criminal involvement. It examines offenders’ characteristics as reported by victims in the NCVS and provides information on racial and ethnic disparities beyond an arrestee and population-based comparison.
