The Attorney General's Office has completed processing your records request received on July 12, 2021 seeking: "All email communications ... between ... Attorney General Sean Reyes, or anyone communicating on Reyes' behalf, such as a chief of staff, scheduler, or assistant" and various US Department of Justice Officials. You also request similar communications with specific attorneys general staff nationwide, and federal and local congressmen that contain certain specified 'key terms,' all since September 20, 2020.

Despite a reasonable search, the Office found no records responsive to your request. This completes the response to your request.
