

United States Constitution

Article I, Section 2

No Person shall be a Representative who shall not have attained to the **Age of twenty five Years**, and been **seven Years a Citizen** of the United States, and who shall not, when elected, be an **Inhabitant of that State** in which he shall be chosen.

United States Constitution

Article I, Section 2

The actual **Enumeration** shall be made within three Years after the first Meeting of the Congress of the United States, and within every subsequent Term of **ten Years**, in such Manner as they shall by Law direct.

United States Constitution

Article XIV, Section 2

Representatives shall be **apportioned** among the several States according to their respective numbers, counting the **whole number of persons in each State**, excluding Indians not taxed.

Missouri Constitution

Article III, Section 45

...the general assembly shall **by law** divide the state into districts corresponding with the number of representatives to which it is entitled, which districts shall be composed of **contiguous territory** as **compact** and as **nearly equal in population** as may be.

To repeal sections 128.345, 128.346, and 128.348, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof eleven new sections relating to the composition of congressional districts.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Sections 128.345, 128.346, and 128.348, RSMo, are repealed and eleven new
2 sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 128.345, 128.346, 128.348, 128.451,
3 128.452, 128.453, 128.454, 128.455, 128.456, 128.457, and 128.458, to read as follows:

128.345. All references in sections [128.400 to 128.440] **128.451 to 128.458** to counties,
2 voting districts (VTD), and tract-blocks [(BLK)] (**Block**) mean those counties, voting districts
3 (VTD), and tract-blocks [(BLK)] (**Block**) as reported to the state by the United States Bureau of
4 the Census for the [2000] **2010** census.

128.346. The districts established by the provisions of sections 128.400 to 128.440 for
2 the election of representatives to the Congress of the United States shall be effective beginning
3 with election to the 108th Congress and **through the election of the 112th Congress. The**
4 **districts established by sections 128.451 to 128.458 for the election of representatives to the**
5 **Congress of the United States shall be effective beginning with the election to the 113th**
6 **Congress.**

128.348. The state of Missouri is hereby divided into nine congressional districts.
2 **Effective with the election for the 113th Congress, the state of Missouri shall consist of**
3 **eight congressional districts.** The legal voters of each district shall elect one member of
4 Congress of the United States.

Partisan Gerrymandering

- nonjusticiable political question
- *Rucho v. Common Cause* (USSCT 2019)
- *Koster v. Pearson* (Mo. 2012)

Compact

- No overall definition of “as compact as may be”
- Traditional considerations may be used: political boundaries, geography, population density, historical boundaries
- Mathematical tests
- Eyeball test or “visual examination”
- “Closely united territory” is main consideration

Voting Rights Act of 1965

- Section 2. No voting qualification or prerequisite to voting, or standard, practice, or procedure shall be imposed or applied by any State or political subdivision to deny or abridge the right of any citizen of the United States to vote on account of race or color.
- 15th Amendment: The right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of race, color, or previous condition of servitude.

Voting Rights Act of 1965

- Race must not be “predominate factor” in drawing district
- To prevent voter dilution
- *Thornberg v. Gingles* (USSCT 1986) “3 part test”
- VRA may require creation of a “majority-minority” district


