Delegate Linville – Evan forwarded your email to me.

Frontier was to have deployed to 100% of its CAF II locations in eligible areas of West Virginia by December 31, 2020. In order to give carriers time to finalize their records, the Commission adopted a March 1, 2021 filing deadline to report those locations and certify that it met the final milestone. Prior year's deployment is available here (can be searched by fund, state, carrier, and deployment year): <https://data.usac.org/publicreports/caf-map/>.

In the meantime, if Frontier knows or suspects it may not have met that December 31 deadline, it is required to give the FCC notice within 10 business days of the deployment deadline (or, January 15). For example, see Frontier's 2020 letter: <https://ecfsapi.fcc.gov/file/10115075584633/FTR%20YE%202019%20CAF%20Letter%201.15.20.pdf>.

Commission rules do permit Frontier a year to come back into compliance. Depending on the size of the gap between Frontier's reported deployment and its obligation, it could be subject to more frequent reporting and withholding of support. If Frontier is unable to come back into compliance, the Commission will recover a portion of Frontier's CAF II support based on the size of the final gap.

Delegate Linville, here is the information that Frontier provided in response to your request. If you need anything further please don't hesitate to contact me. Thanks.

Frontier has until 12/31/2021 to complete its deployments under the FCC's CAF II program, which we plan to do. Although the original target for 2020 was 100%, the FCC provided until YE2021 for carriers to complete their builds.

Under CAF II rules, Frontier is required to reach 89,190 homes and businesses in FCC-identified census blocks. The obligation is the aggregate number across the state, not any individual home in any individual census block.


Presently, Frontier expects to expand/improve service utilizing CAF II funding and its own investment to extend 10/1 Mbps service to over 1k households this year in Cabell County. The county will also be seeing gigabit investment in eligible areas that Frontier won as part of RDOF.

As many of you know, the FCC recently completed the initial phase of the Rural Digital Opportunity Fund Reverse Auction. The provisional results of the auction are that nine providers won provisional bids in West Virginia totaling \$362 million serving 119,267 locations across the state.

Of that sum, Frontier Communications received \$247 million to serve 79,391 locations with gigabit level speed over the next ten years. Senator Capito has significant concerns about the ability of Frontier Communications to meet the commitment of gigabit service, both from a technological and financial standpoint. Therefore, earlier today she a letter to the FCC urging them to review Frontier’s long-form application with the utmost scrutiny and if there is any indication that they cannot meet the commitment to deliver gigabit level service to the 79,391 locations in West Virginia their long-form application should be rejected.

I know this is a very complex matter and if you would like to discuss further, I am happy to discuss offline.

Capito Cautions FCC on RDOF Funding for Frontier

WASHINGTON, D.C. – U.S. Senator Shelley Moore Capito (R-W.Va.) today [sent a letter](#) to Federal Communications Commission (FCC) Chairman Ajit Pai voicing her concerns about the ability of Frontier Communications to meet the obligations required by the Rural Digital Opportunity Fund (RDOF) auction program. This letter follows yesterday's [announcement](#) that nine providers won bids to cover West Virginia through the RDOF program.

“If, during the review of Frontier’s long-form application for the West Virginia locations there are any questions or concerns about their ability to deliver on the commitment made in their short form application, I urge the FCC to reject their long-form application. The stakes are simply too high to provide nearly \$250 million to a company that does not have the capability to deliver on the commitments made to the FCC. West Virginia cannot afford to be let down, yet again, by the failure of Frontier to deliver on promises made to federal partners,” **Senator Capito wrote.**

Dear Chairman Pai,

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) plays an imperative role in addressing the critical need for broadband access across the United States, especially in rural America. Over the last five years, I have worked as your partner in Congress to successfully increase funding for existing programs, created new programs to increase the availability of broadband in rural communities, and worked to update our nations mapping so that we can more efficiently target unserved areas in our country.

The largest opportunity that we have to close the digital divide, is the Rural Digital Opportunity Fund (RDOF), providing funding to deploy broadband in rural America over the next decade. On December 7, 2020, the FCC announced that an estimated 218,000 West Virginians will gain access to high-speed broadband through the Rural Digital Opportunity Fund Phase I auction. This auction allocated \$362,066,660.20 in support to expand broadband to 119,267 unserved homes and businesses in West Virginia. While I am pleased that the auction encouraged robust competition that resulted in nine providers winning support in my state, I continue to have concerns about the ability of Frontier Communications (Frontier) to meet the obligations expected of them as a gigabit tier provider.

As you move forward with the more in depth review of successful bidders long-

form application, I urge you to review Frontier's submissions to ensure they will be able to honor their obligations to provide gigabit level service in over 79,391 locations across West Virginia. Frontier's mismanagement of prior federal funding through the Broadband Technology Opportunity Fund program, resulting in \$4.7 million in funds repaid to the federal government for improper use, raises significant questions about their ability to manage federal funds of this magnitude.

Furthermore, Frontier has a documented pattern of history demonstrating inability to meet FCC deadlines for completion of Connect America Fund Phase II support in West Virginia. The inability to deploy federal funds in a timely fashion to make improvements to a network delivering broadband service at speeds of 10/1Mbps or higher should raise significant concerns about their capacity to build out a network delivering one hundred times that level.

Specifically with regards to Frontier's assigned performance tier, I urge you to exert the utmost scrutiny to ensure they have the technological capability to deliver gigabit level service in West Virginia. As stated in the Federal Register dated June 18, 2020, the FCC reserves the right to reject an applicant's long-form application if they do not meet the technical qualifications for the performance tier in which they were permitted to bid. Based on Frontier's current and previous performance, I am concerned they lack the technological capabilities in West Virginia to transition from a provider that struggles to deliver the FCC minimum standard of 25/3 Mbps to a provider that is able to provide gigabit level service to 95 percent of the required number of locations in the state.

Secondly, I urge you to closely scrutinize the financial capability of Frontier to finance these investments, particularly as they emerge from a Chapter 11 financial restructuring. Because of the nature of a reverse auction, it is entirely possible, if not likely that a bidder will be required to invest their own funds to cover costs above and beyond the subsidy provided by RDOF. Emerging from a financial restructuring requires significant private capital and I am concerned about the ability of Frontier to raise sufficient capital to both complete their financial restructuring and fund the construction of a network that will deliver the required gigabit level service in the locations they successfully bid in the RDOF auction. The expense of constructing a network capable of delivering gigabit service is an expensive and daunting feat for a company in a strong financial position, let alone one that is in financial turmoil.

Furthermore, based on the total amount provisionally awarded in the RDOF auction, the average subsidy per location is less than fifty percent. Frontier will undoubtedly have to supplement the RDOF subsidy with private capital in order

to construct a network capable of delivering gigabit level service. At an estimated average reserve subsidy of 47 percent of the initial reserve price for census blocks, Frontier would need to raise over \$250 million in private capital to fund the buildout of a gigabit network in West Virginia. I urge the FCC to closely scrutinize Frontier's ability to secure this amount of private capital, considering they are in the midst of a complex financial restructuring.

The COVID-19 pandemic has proven that access to true broadband service is no longer an optional luxury, it is a core component of everyday life. The funding made available by the RDOF auction presents a transformational opportunity for West Virginia to take a substantial step towards closing the digital divide in our state. However, that will only occur if the companies constructing these networks truly have the ability to deliver the gigabit level of service they've committed to with their short form applications.

If, during the review of Frontier's long-form application for the West Virginia locations there are any questions or concerns about their ability to deliver on the commitment made in their short form application, I urge the FCC to reject their long-form application. The stakes are simply too high to provide nearly \$250 million to a company that does not have the capability to deliver on the commitments made to the FCC. West Virginia cannot afford to be let down, yet again, by the failure of Frontier to deliver on promises made to federal partners.

Thank you for your consideration of this critical matter. I will continue to be your partner in expanding broadband throughout rural America.



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

Dear Delegate Howell,

Thank you for contacting me regarding the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) actions with regards to the conversion of motor vehicles for racing competition. I appreciate the opportunity to learn your views on this important subject.

As you know, in 2015 the Obama Administration EPA proposed to prohibit actions that change the configuration of a motor vehicle the design of which was certified by the Department of Transportation, and was sold to the consumer for, use on public roads; specifically, those actions that modify or disable emissions control technology. While subsequently withdrawn, this proposal threatened to upend motorsports activities by prohibiting the conversion of road-legal motor vehicles for exclusive use as racecars, in contravention of existing law. Such a policy change would have made the hobby of amateur racing, and even some disciplines of professional racing, beyond the financial reach of many American enthusiasts. It would also be logistically beyond the enforcement capability of the EPA itself, passing an unfunded mandate onto states and local governments to enforce EPA regulations, likely through a federalization of vehicle registration systems.

In response to this attempted overreach, I joined with several of my colleagues in the 114th and 115th Congresses in cosponsoring the Recognizing the Protection of Motorsports (RPM) Act. This legislation would specifically prevent the EPA from ever regulating the conversion of motor vehicles used solely for competition. While we were unsuccessful in advancing this legislation before, I will continue to support

efforts that protect the motorsports industry from excessive regulation. You will be pleased to know that I joined with my colleagues to reintroduce a new version of this legislation on October 16, 2019.
