This letter responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Office of the Solicitor General (OSG), dated November 30, 2021, in which you requested the following:

- “1. All call logs for the officials specified below in Part 2, or anyone communicating on their behalf, such as a Chief of Staff, executive assistant, or secretary, between January 4 and January 7, 2021.
  
2. Any records reflecting the substance of and participants in calls or meetings that the officials specified below participated in between January 4 and January 7, 2021, including agendas, meeting minutes or summaries (including handwritten notes and informal email summaries), participant lists, and any materials exchanged by parties attending any such call:
  - a. Acting Solicitor General Jeffrey Wall
  - b. Assistant to the Solicitor General Christopher Michel.”

Under the Freedom of Information Act, an individual is entitled to receive access to certain materials in identifiable agency records. OSG maintains primary pertinent records on current or recent past United States Supreme Court cases in which the federal government has participated. We also maintain records on adverse decisions submitted for the Solicitor General’s decision regarding whether to seek further judicial review.

OSG reviewed records responsive to the search terms specified in your request for responsiveness. Based on that review, OSG located no records that are responsive to the request.
