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To the citizens of the United States of America,

We the undersigned state legislators of the United States are vested with the plenary power by our US Constitution (Article 2 Section 1 Clause 2) to oversee the election of the president of the United States.

It has come to our attention from an audit of 2.1 million ballots in Arizona complemented by an in-depth canvass of votes in Arizona, as well as through multiple different data reviews of voting by independent experts; that our representative republic suffered a corrupted 2020 election.

In addition to Arizona, sworn affidavits have accumulated from our own states detailing rampant corruption and mismanagement in the election process. Brett is most flexible for Friday afternoon so it appears to be optimal. **You're all welcome to meet here at my home @ 4:00 PM on Friday. (8009 NW 11th Court)**

Since your email indicated you plan to be at Elections Dept. this morning to observe and meet with Kimsey, please know that our Signature Verification Certified Election Observers have been told by the Elections Supervisor (Cathie Garber) that their job is to 'observe only' and NOT report anything to her that they believe is an error or questionable. She has told at least 3 of our observers in no uncertain terms that she will not take any time to review what they present to her. This has discouraged many of them and flies in the face of CC Auditor & Elections Dept. claims of 'transparency, accuracy, and public involvement'. Below is an example that pretty well sums it up. So far I've held off sending this as I expect that Kimsey and Cathie will 'STAND' on their RCW and WAC: WAC 434-250-110 and WAC 434-261-020 along with their associated RCW references. If they in fact stand on Horrible LEGISLATION (RCW and WAC) it proves that at least one root cause is in Olympia plus weak Elections Dept.'s lacking common sense on masking, vaxing, and muzzling of citizen volunteer CEO s willing, ABLE , and frequently qualified to assist. Gov't over reach destroys our Republic. **You're welcome to deliver the statement below on EIT's behalf if you feel so inclined or advise us whether to send the draft email or not.**

Election observers and political party monitors are important elements of election integrity. They monitor the process in order to detect and deter integrity problems. They also increase electoral transparency by publicly reporting on their findings and making an informed judgement on the freeness, fairness and credibility of the process.

We're very disappointed and discouraged to receive reports from our CEO s serving in Signature Verification this election. One of the reports summed it up pretty well.

I went ahead and went in this morning, knowing there probably wouldn't be many ballots to review by the time I got there. I got checked in and Cathie gave me an orientation. I asked about the procedure if I saw a problem or disagreed with a signature verification. She said this year she is not reviewing anything from the CEOs on signature verification. She said our job for signature verification is simply to observe the process. Of course it begs the question, why are we even there if we can't bring up issues on the spot? I guess if I see something that I have a question about, I'll make a note of it and report it to you.

The second and third CEO reports I received were similar in content. (Henry Harbert –WSP Signature Trained, Clark County Certified Election Observer, a retired dentist and Rick Vermeers – a retired Electrical Engineer)

The communication suggests you're short staffed. If not then your dept's true intent may be to tout, showcase, and advertise how good, secure, accurate, and transparent everything is inside the Clark County Elections Dept. while muzzling 'Certified Election Observers at the 8 Sig Verif duty stations'. Your words to these volunteer patriot CEO s clearly demonstrated lack of transparency, discouraged volunteer

participation, and justifies our open request for a full forensic election audit. If the reason is that you don't have time to consider valid concerns perhaps you do not have adequate staffing and it should be remedied.

This is insulting to we the people citizens of Clark County WA and especially to CEO s who volunteer to serve while paying their tax \$ to fund your salaries and benefit plans.

Please clarify upon receipt. If it is a travesty of communication, it is still a sad violation of good faith common sense transparency in the Clark County Elections department. Combined with the illegal masking rule/mandate it appears and feels like violations of equal protection under the law.

We look forward to your retraction and will readily accept apologies for the miscommunication. I will forward the same to all 150 GOP CEO s and press channels who I'm quite sure will appreciate clarification and perhaps it will serve as a step toward rebuilding confidence in the dept's common goal of overseeing free and fair elections with integrity on citizen's behalf.

PS – As you may have heard I was escorted out of Elections Dept. on October 7 while attempting to perform my Certified Election Observer duties for the Logic & Accuracy Test. Auditor claimed I had submit to their RULES for masking requirement. I conveyed that I have a medical exemption due to having had nose surgery procedures to help my breathing. Two months prior for the August Primary masking was optional/choice. The science proves the masks to be ineffective. Private security agents backed up by Clark County Sheriff Deputies (who were very courteous and professional) were called by Auditor Kimsey to escort me out of the Elections Building. Masking mandates are not law as far as I'm aware of.

This 2021 election cycle is at risk for fraud as well, and any evidence we can capture from this election may provide significant intelligence on the intent and operations of the criminal fraud network. There are multiple scenarios that could be revealed, and any evidence we gather will tighten the noose.

Ballots have been mailed. If you receive ballots for anyone other than the registered voters at your household, secure the ballot – don't throw it away – and reach out to my team at 719 401 0486.

Discuss the situation with the volunteer responding to your report, then determine how to handle the ballot so it will not be misused.

This is an easy way for honest citizens concerned about election fraud to help America clean up the system and ensure every valid vote is counted. No eligible voter should ever be disenfranchised by irregularities or fraud.


