Thank you for contacting the Governor's Office. It is our understanding you are requesting copies of the following records:

- Email communications sent by Governor Reynolds or anyone communicating on her behalf such as a chief of staff, scheduler, or assistant from September 29, 2021 through November 1, 2021, regarding the Governor's trip to the U.S.-Mexico border on or about October 6, 2021.
- Records reflecting any expenses and costs incurred or paid by the Governor's Office related to the Governor's trip to the U.S.-Mexico border on or about October 6, 2021.

To locate potentially responsive email records, we directed our technology office to search the email accounts of the Governor and the employees identified and/or requested above for emails sent from September 29, 2021 through November 1, 2021, that also contained any one of the following terms: "U.S.-Mexico" or "border". Any emails returned based on that criteria were then reviewed to determine whether they are responsive to your request.

You will receive a separate email from our staff sharing a Microsoft OneDrive folder with you that contains our response to your request. One file, in PDF format, contains electronic copies of responsive records ("R189_American Oversight.pdf"). Any redaction of responsive records was made, where necessary, pursuant to section 22.7(50) of the Iowa Code. Other responsive records were withheld pursuant to section 22.7(65) of the Iowa Code.

Please inform me once you download a copy of the files from the Microsoft OneDrive folder. If I do not hear otherwise, I plan to remove your access to this folder at 5 p.m. on Tuesday, February 8, 2022. Please also let me know if you have any difficulties accessing the folder or need additional time to do so. (Depending on your email account, any verification code sent from Microsoft may be routed to your spam folder.)

This response does not waive the confidentiality of any document or record under any applicable provision of the Iowa Open Records Act, chapter 22 of the Iowa Code, or other law.

Texas Department of Public Safety Deployment

Colonel Fulk Remarks

Good morning. On July 8th, 27 Troopers and 1 Special Agent traveled to Texas to support the Texas Department of Public Safety. The Troopers worked on the ground supporting Texas DPS for 12 days and returned to Iowa on July 22nd.

The Iowa State Patrol sent 12 Road Troopers, 12 Tactical Team Troopers, 3 Supervisors and 1 Special Agent.

The Iowa State Patrol Command Staff strategically selected the 27 Troopers that traveled to Texas. The personnel selected for this assignment are stationed throughout the state of Iowa. Our goal was to ensure there was no negative impact to our daily operations in Iowa. We facilitate a similar practice of selecting personnel to support RAGBRAI and the Iowa State Fair. All personnel that traveled to support the Texas DPS volunteered for this assignment.

The **Iowa State Patrol Road Troopers** paired up and worked with Texas DPS Troopers to provide humanitarian aid at several key locations.

- Our personnel encountered 184 undocumented persons at the Rio Grande river crossing.
- Provided humanitarian support to 800 or more undocumented individuals at the U.S. Border fence by providing food, water and medical care to those in need.
- Throughout our deployment, we encountered approximately 1,400 undocumented individuals.

ISP Road Troopers performed traffic enforcement duties, assisted with 2 pursuits, 3 impaired drivers, 6 narcotics arrests, a traffic stop involving child exploitation and assisted with 12 felony arrests

Iowa State Patrol Tactical Officers

- ISP Tactical Team members assisted with locating individuals attempting to evade law enforcement.
- A secondary team assisted with investigations of human smuggling and narcotics trafficking.

While working in Texas, Iowa Department of Public Safety Law Enforcement Personnel were involved in 12 **human smuggling investigations**. (transporting, children)

During the July 9th – 22nd timeframe, the overall law enforcement collaborative efforts led to 240 criminal arrests, 51 motor vehicle pursuits, the seizure of 948 pounds of marijuana, 37 pounds of cocaine & methamphetamine, 18 firearms and \$1,703,690 in currency seizures.

Yesterday, I spoke with Texas DPS Assistant Chief of the Texas Highway Patrol, Justin Chrane. He stated, “We value our partnership with the members of the Iowa State Patrol and the personnel from Iowa enhanced safety for the Texas Troopers and the public.”

Captain Mark Miller with the Iowa State Patrol volunteered and was also hand selected to lead Iowa’s deployment to Texas. He previously deployed with the National Guard for approximately 6 months supervising 650 Airmen and Soldiers working border security operations in the state of Arizona. We are very proud of Captain Miller and our personnel that deployed to Texas. It is my pleasure to introduce Captain Mark Miller of the Iowa State Patrol.

Worked in the Del Rio Sector.

Traffic Interdiction, Humanitarian Efforts

Working in coordination with the Texas Department of Public Safety, Nebraska State Patrol, and Florida Fish & Wildlife.

(Target human smugglers, back-up to Texas DPS, Assist on bail outs, gathered intelligence)

2. Humanitarian Efforts

(Worked the river crossing, helped maintain the welfare of the undocumented immigrants, assisted border agents)


