This responds to your Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”) request dated and received by the Office of the Director of National Intelligence on 10 January 2022, in which you requested “*all email communications (including emails, email attachments, complete email chains, calendar invitations, and calendar invitation attachments) and text messages or messages on messaging platforms (such as Slack, GChat or Google Hangouts, Lync, Skype, Twitter direct messages, Facebook messages, WhatsApp, Signal, Telegram, or Parler) between (a) the former agency officials specified in Column A and (b) the external individuals and entities listed in Column B, including, but not limited to, at the provided email addresses or domains*”.

Your request was processed under the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended. After a thorough search in our records and databases, were unable to locate any records responsive to your request.
