This letter responds to your Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”) letter dated 10 January 2022 and received by the Office of the Director of National Intelligence on 11 January 2022, in which you requested “*All documents provided by your agency to the Select Committee to Investigate the January 6th Attack on the United States Capitol and the Senate Judiciary Committee regarding the 2020 presidential election, claims of election fraud, or the January 6, 2021 insurrection attempt on the United States Capitol.*” You further specified a timeframe of January 3, 2021 through the date of search.

The records you requested are currently the subject of another FOIA case which has gone into litigation and, therefore, cannot be released until the litigation case has been completed. For this reason, we are administratively closing your case at this time. Once the litigation case is finalized, we will post the records in our reading room on the dni.gov web site.
