Dear Commissioners,

I am Jonna Lou Schafer and I am writing in regards to Agenda Item #14 in the upcoming 8/12/21 Commission meeting. My thoughts deal with past elections and future elections.

I attended a meeting at Weed prior to the 2020 election where individuals who were running for various offices spoke to the crowd. We were assured that the voting machines would NOT be connected to the internet and that there was no way that our votes could be tampered with. History shows that this was NOT correct. In fact, internet was hurriedly provided to rural "convenience voting centers" in order for rural residents to have a place to vote without having to drive to Alamogordo. Tallied votes were to be sent directly to the County Clerk's Office via WiFi. I am not 'tech savvy' but I have been told that WiFi is the least secure of internet connections.

I am not accusing our County Clerk or any other county officials of vote fraud. However, I do believe that vote fraud was rampant nationwide and may well have happened in our own county. From the evidence that is being brought forward in other states, votes could have been changed and/or 'cyber-flipped' without our local election officials ever being aware. I even watched it happen on national TV where newscasters would be reporting live showing that President Trump had a comfortable

to significant lead over Vice-President Biden and suddenly the vote numbers would flip showing VP Biden with the comfortable to significant lead. Most newscasters were dumbfounded. This is not statistically possible.

Mike Lindell, Sidney Powell, and others have reported that there is proof that China, Spain, Italy, Germany, and possibly others had direct internet/ cyber links to our 2020 election process and that there was interference with "the people's vote". Seth Keshel also believes that there were major discrepancies nationwide in the 2020 election. Mr. Keshel is identified on LinkedIn as an executive and former baseball analyst. Mr. Keshel does not specify any electoral experience but he notes in his report, *"the state-by-state tally of Biden's "excess votes" are "lenient" estimates that require further research."* He frequently repeats the false claim that the numbers suggest fraud. Seth Keshel analyzed the election results following the November 2020 presidential election based on voter registration levels and actual votes. In several counties, he found alarming irregularities that differed from trend lines that (in many cases) had been reliable for over 100 years. Accordingly, he has published reports for both counties and states that indicate which counties' votes correspond with voter registration trends and which have small or large deviations from these trends. He claims that there is a distinct possibility that there could be 84,000 votes (16.7%) in the state of New Mexico that are suspect.

I am aware that County Commissions have no control over what "laws" the state legislature pass, but it is the County Commissions duty to protect the health, safety, and general welfare of its residents when it implements said laws. It is my belief that County Commissioners, whomever they may be, have a fiduciary duty to uphold constitutional law and not to enforce law that is contrary and/or repugnant to either the United States Constitution or the New Mexico Constitution.

It is my opinion that Article 3, NMSA §1-3-4, *"Consolidation of precincts; voter convenience centers"* is contradictory with Article 3, NMSA §1-1-12, *"Consolidated precinct"* and Article 3, NMSA §1-3-1, *"Nature of a precinct; maps"*.

Article 3, NMSA §1-1-12, Annotations is an Attorney General's opinion which addresses the constitutional requisite for consolidation; *"Any statute providing for consolidation of precincts in any given election is void and unconstitutional unless the old precincts are abolished and a new precinct, including the area desired to be consolidated, is legally created. 1954 Op. Att'y Gen. No. 54-6067 (opinion rendered*

*under former law).*" I believe that this opinion solidifies that Article 3, NMSA §1-3-4, "Consolidation of precincts; voter convenience centers" is unconstitutional and should be considered null and void since no old precincts were abolished and no new precincts were created.

Article 3 NMSA §1-3-1 specifically describes how precincts are divided and boundaries are set. Voters are required to vote at the appointed polling places located within their particular precinct. Article 3, NMSA §1-3-4, allows the County Commission to pass a resolution to consolidate precincts creating "voting convenience centers" and to determine the location(s) of said voting convenience centers. This resolution allows voters to vote anywhere in the county that they choose. (resolutions are not law) Again, it is my opinion that such regulation is in direct conflict with Article 3, NMSA §1-3-1, therefore contrary to constitutional law and should be considered null and void.

I believe that you, as our County Commissioners, have the responsibility to protect the general welfare of the county residents. Voting integrity is an integral part of the welfare of the county residents (putting the interests of everyone over the benefits of a select group or a few people). It is my belief that voting convenience centers severely obstruct voting integrity and are unconstitutional. I respectfully ask that you, as our public representatives, protect our constitutional voting rights in the future by enforcing Article 3, NMSA 1-3-1 and by using paper ballot voting only, no voting machines, most especially Dominion or Smartmatic.
