CWA: I wanted you to know about the *Houston Chronicle* opinion page Monday, September 27, 2021

On page A17 an opinion piece called the upcoming audit (quote) "embarrassing"

One quote that I would also point out: "*there was no evidence of widespread voter fraud in 2020.*" (in Texas)

I disagree with that statement, but maybe there is wiggle-room in the definition of the word: "**widespread**"?

Certainly there was some degree of voter fraud in some form in almost all 254 counties in Texas, and not just the four your office is allegedly going to audit; for example, there were thousands of felons either on probation or parole who voted in Texas despite the TECode saying that a felon voting is committing another (2nd degree) felony by illegally voting! This was definitely "widespread" and I know the exact names and addresses (correlated/cross-referenced) because the data is public and available.

Indeed, I don't know the scope of what the Sec'y. of State considers a full forensic audit, b/c it is a multi-faceted problem. That's why I'm emailing you, and also because I have travelled a similar path: e.g., Univ. of Texas undergrad, and SMU Law School, are my degrees, just like you!

I would like to help with the SOS audit, either as a full-time employee, part-time employee, or as a consultant. I'm a former prosecutor, w/ extensive experience in a large independent E&P corporation which gave me an eye to detail, finance, auditing, legal documents, etc.

If you have sent others to the four counties, I would be willing to take up their dockets of cases, or go to each county and help assimilate the data needed to find the voter fraud that surely exists. I can start by providing you the complete list of felons who voted in the 2020 election. They committed a state jail felony by merely attempting to unlawfully cast a ballot, although I'm sure many would say *they didn't know it was illegal?*

The Chron.com opinion piece calls the audit a threat, and "setting the stage for a

constitutional crisis," however, when the evidence of fraud is discovered, in whatever form, I doubt they will write another (retraction) op-ed article. The democratic process should have zero tolerance for negligence, fraud, or criminal activity within our state elections, and I hope you have success in your efforts, but let me repeat: I would like to help.


