Once you access the download link using the key provided, please download your voter list to a secure location right away. The download link will expire in 30 days. When it does, all stored data will be deleted – including the list itself.

The file will be in a compressed, or “zipped”, folder archive. It can be unzipped using a number of software programs. For Windows users, we recommend WinZip or 7zip. They are free to download, and easy to install and to use.

Additionally, due to the size of certain voter lists, some spreadsheet software (such as Excel or Numbers) may not be able to open these files in their entirety. There are well over 7 million records in the Georgia statewide voter list. To access the complete information in larger files, you may need to use more specialized software.

Including any standard processes related to how the counties in your state update the voter rolls and the relationship they have with your office.

If your agency does not maintain these public records, please let me know who does and include the proper custodian's name and address. As provided in the open records law, O.C.G.A. § 50-18-71(b)(1)(A), I will expect your response within three (3) business days. Should a proper response take longer, please notify me immediately. Please provide all information electronically/digitally (PDF Preferred) via email. I agree to pay any reasonable copying and postage fees of not more than \$50 with a receipt provided indicating the charges for each document should they exceed such cost. A. A list of all entities with integrations, APIs, connections, accounts, contracts, agreements, or similar means of adding, importing, exporting, editing, supplying, tracking, validating, or monitoring voter registration or voter history data.

B. Copies of any and all contracts, agreements, accounts, subscriptions, invoices, decrees, or written standards of any sort that document the relationships with any entity listed in Section A of this request.

C. Any and all copies of requests for production, technical documents, operating guides, training manuals, contracts, invoices related in any way to your state's voter registration management system(s) software(s) used from 2016 to the present.

D. Copies of all policies and procedures detailing the processes your state followed to validate the accuracy of incoming voter registration applications and information.

E. A copy of a list of all data providers or sources your state used to validate voter identity, along with the data element(s) they provide verification of.

F. A copy of a list of all data providers or sources your state used to validate voter residency, along with the data element(s) they provide verification of.

G. A list of all data providers or sources used to validate voter citizenship, along with the data element(s) they provide verification of.

H. Copies of any and all lists of all additional data providers or sources used to validate voter records that impact eligibility, including but not limited to criminal records, any interstate databases (by name), any intrastate databases (by name), etc., along with the data element(s) they provide verification of.

I. Copies of all policies and procedures detailing the processes followed to manage and maintain voter records, including but not limited to all steps taken to ensure accuracy of individual records, criteria for removal of records, maintenance schedules, and schedules related to voter notification and response requirements.

J. Sample copies of all notifications, messages, reports, letters, or other correspondence sent to voters related to their voter registration status.

K. Copies of any list, by date, of records removed from the registry, including all voter information, and the reason for removal.

If your agency does not maintain these public records, please let me know who does and include the proper custodian's name and address. I am requesting copies of the video recordings created by security cameras used to surveil all ballot drop boxes in Fulton County for the November 2020 Election under the Georgia Open Records Law OCGA §50-18-70. We respectfully request to be provided with electronic copies of each of the following documents, files, or images, as soon as they become available. Specifically, we are requesting video captured during the absentee ballot voting period for the November 2020 General Election, beginning when the boxes were opened in October through the election until drop box security footage stopped recording. Please denote location and date of each recording.

This request is being sent to your office because your office claimed to have done an investigation into the November General Election and the claims arising therein. If your agency does not maintain these public records, please let me know who does and include the proper custodian's name and address. Further, if there is a reason why your agency does not have these records, please give a brief explanation why.

As provided in the open records law, O.C.G.A. § 50-18-71(b)(1)(A), I will expect your response within three (3) business days. If you choose to deny this request, please provide a written explanation for the denial including a reference to the specific statutory exemption(s) upon which you rely. O.C.G.A. § 50-18-71(d).
