Hi Dr. Ladapo,

I'm grateful that Jay was willing to introduce us, and I want to welcome you to Florida. I initially connected with Jay through Rational Ground, and I have now met him in person twice in Tallahassee.

I live near Gainesville, in Alachua County, and we would LOVE your help with our school board (the county commission's mask mandate just reached the maximum 42 days, so I hope we're done with that, although the city commission is talking about a permanent mask mandate that can be instituted at the whim of the City Manager).

Our problem is UF, where the mask cult is strong (but the State University System won't let them mandate masks on campus, so they're focusing on masking our children). Our school board only listens to the UF doctors (it is an article of faith on our local boards that UF experts are the best experts), but as Surgeon General, you have the ability to ask to be a presenter at their meetings. They used to invite the county department of health but stopped (but the guy who did the county DOH presentation wasn't very helpful because his standard presentation recommends masks - the county presentations are a whole 'nother issue that we can talk about if you'd like; the people who put them together work for you! And Paul Myers started out agreeing with me on COVID policies but I think has been beaten down by the UF people).

Anyway, I'm sure you know that our school board is defying the FDOH emergency rule, and they would probably do so without the constant advice of UF doctors, but our side isn't even represented by the "experts" who give presentations. You can present remotely.

As Jay mentioned, I run a local news site, Alachua Chronicle. Here is my story about last night's meeting, but I only had time to write about the board discussion. I think, as Surgeon General, you should take the time to watch the doctors' presentations to see what we're up against; several things they said were blatantly false. Our board chair last night said she listens to the UF doctors, "although we have one mistake who just got appointed."
