Dear Stakeholders,

Allocation amounts for COVID-19 therapeutics to states, territories, federal entities, Test to Treat Program partners, and Long-Term Care Pharmacy Program partners have been determined for the period of April 11-17, 2022. **Bebtelovimab, Lagevrio (molnupiravir), and Paxlovid are included in today's allocations.**

As a reminder, [Sotrovimab distribution is paused to all U.S. states and territories](#). The [FDA originally announced](#) in March that Sotrovimab is not authorized for use in regions where infection is likely to have been caused by a non-susceptible SARS-CoV-2 variant, and studies suggest that sotrovimab is not fully active against the BA.2 variant. On April 5, FDA updated the Sotrovimab product [Fact Sheet](#) to restrict use in all U.S states and territories. Accordingly, ASPR immediately paused distribution of Sotrovimab to all regions. [Nowcast data from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention \(CDC\)](#) continues to show that the proportion of COVID-19 cases caused by the BA.2 variant is above 50% in all HHS regions.

Additionally, please keep in mind these important notes regarding this week’s allocations:

- Evusheld is allocated on a monthly basis. State and territorial health departments received their monthly allocation of Evusheld on April 8.
- All unordered courses of Bebtelovimab, Lagevrio, and Paxlovid are swept at the end of each week and placed into the federal pool for reallocation; unordered Evusheld is swept at the end of the month.
- Eligible jurisdictions in need of additional product above their allocated amount can request more product through the appropriate [ASPR Regional Emergency Coordinator](#).
- Allocations of oral antivirals Lagevrio and Paxlovid for the Test to Treat Program and Long-Term Care Pharmacy Program are included in today’s amounts. Additional information regarding the Test to Treat program, including the [Test to Treat site locator](#), can be found on [ASPR’s website](#).

Given that we have a vendor agreement with Cardinal Health for the purchase and distribution of approximately \$130,000,000 to \$150,000,000 of pharmaceuticals annually, and that the definition of "Products" includes at least one prescription drug on our inventory list (Gabapentin), it would be prudent to except out that contract from the release. The terms of the Settlement Agreement provide that it should be construed as broadly as possible to encompass released claims. And, the "Covered Conduct" includes obligations of Cardinal Health under the MMCAP vendor contract. I attached some proposed language for consideration.





As a court-upheld vaccine mandate takes hold at local hospitals, some local healthcare workers are now looking for new jobs.

Tallahassee Memorial HealthCare, which employs about 5,500 workers, has fired 10 employees for not meeting the requirement to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 by Feb. 26, according to a hospital spokesperson.

Three percent of employees have not met the requirement or applied for a medical or religious exemption at HCA Florida Capital Hospital — which was previously Capital Regional Medical Center — said spokesperson Rachel Stiles in a statement.

"Compliance with the various CMS deadlines and state requirements are priority while we continue to enforce safety protocols and focus on meeting the healthcare needs of our community," read the statement from Stiles.

HCA officials did not answer specific questions about whether the employees were terminated.

Both healthcare facilities are two of an estimated 76,000 health care facilities — covering some 17 million workers — that were forced to require employees to finish their vaccine, according to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services' (CMS) emergency regulation.

If a hospital rejects the mandate and chooses not to require vaccinations, it risks losing Medicare and Medicaid funding.

All: this is an odd priority for plaintiffs. As we explained to counsel yesterday, our interpretation of the Judge's Order was that we could respond to plaintiffs' show cause submission. It has consistently been our position (as set forth in

our motion to dismiss) that there is no standing for various reasons, including the plaintiffs' reliance on ever-changing CDC guidance, so our response did not introduce new arguments, nor was it an attempt "to get the last word." Our thinking right now is to hold off responding to this (to avoid giving them more air time with a reply), see if Judge Moore decides the substantive issues in the meantime, but plan to file a short response by the 14-day deadline in the event the case is still pending at that point.

Given that we have a vendor agreement with Cardinal Health for the purchase and distribution of approximately \$130,000,000 to \$150,000,000 of pharmaceuticals annually, and that the definition of "Products" includes at least one prescription drug on our inventory list (Gabapentin), it would be prudent to except out that contract from the release. The terms of the Settlement Agreement provide that it should be construed as broadly as possible to encompass released claims. And, the "Covered Conduct" includes obligations of Cardinal Health under the MMCAP vendor contract. I attached some proposed language for consideration.
