Senator Townsend,

Attached is a rendering of what the drop boxes you requested would look like and some very high level specs for the unit.

Costs are a little harder since some of these items have never been incorporated into a ballot drop box. We are confident it can be done, but not exactly sure at what price yet. That being said, we believe \$15K per ballot drop box is a very safe number. Volumes will decrease that price considerably, but wanted to get you a worse case scenario. I hope this gives you something to present and incorporate into election changes. Thanks for trusting Runbeck to be part of the process and as always, let me know if we can do anything else or answer any follow up questions on the drop boxes.

Hi Senator:

In terms of the password issue, I thought you were going to contact the SOS to see about an AVID enhancement that would facilitate new passwords at certain intervals. I can do that if you want but I haven't yet.

In terms of the duplication issue I recently learned that there is already an AVID enhancement in the works to address this issue. I know this is a high priority to get it implemented prior to the fall, but I don't have a specific timeline. Basically the issue is that right now "duplicate checking" is turned off at a certain point inside the system and the upcoming enhancement would change that so that voters with an effective date of change AFTER the registration cutoff date or any cross-county registrations/merges would trigger a new screen or pop up menu. This alert will tell the NEW county that the voter is registered in another county and then the county would have two choices:

1. Put them in a suspended status and hold the registration until the "books are open" (this essentially means post election when new registrations can be added for a future election)
2. Complete the transaction due to UOCAVA status

All counties need to agree to a "books open" date. Also, AVID will need to look at the effective date of change when pulling a voter from county to county.

So, let me know about the password issue and if you want me to reach out to SOS. But it looks like the duplicate registration issue is already on the way to be fixed.

Also, I am told that Runbeck reached back out to you, but just as a double check...AZ should be fine for paper. Runbeck and other vendors used by AZ counties have been planning and stockpiling and every county is on track to have what they need for the Primary and General. Yes, there is a paper shortage nationally, but AZ is set. The one thing counties will have to be even more vigilant about it

proofing. If any county gets into a situation where they would need to reprint something – that might be a challenge. But right now we are going to have everything we need re: paper.
