Dear Counsel:

This email contains information relating to the upcoming oral arguments at 10:00 am on January 7, 2022.

The format for these arguments will be the same as it was during argument sessions this fall. Attendance in the courtroom will be limited to arguing counsel and one co-counsel for each party arguing in the case. To the extent that parties may plan to ask for divided argument in these cases, we ask that you submit motions on the issue by 1 p.m. on

Tuesday, December 28. Denise McNerney will contact you separately concerning the logistics of designating counsel who will be present at argument. Counsel in each case will be expected to be in the Courtroom for both cases on January 7.

Attached is a document that outlines our COVID protocols. The Court asks that all attorneys who plan to be in the Courtroom take a Court-provided PCR COVID test the day before argument. These tests will be administered at a MedStar Health facility at 1120 20th Street, NW, Washington, D.C. at either 8:15am or 8:30am on January 6. We will contact you individually with additional details and the precise time to report. Instructions for access to the testing facility are also attached. We ask that attorneys either sign a waiver so that test results can be reported by Medstar directly to the Court, or report the results to me [REDACTED] [@supremecourt.gov](mailto:[REDACTED]@supremecourt.gov)) promptly after receiving them. (The waiver form will be available at the testing facility.)

In order to review these procedures and answer any last-minute questions that counsel may have, **I will conduct a conference call for attorneys arguing in these cases at 4pm on Tuesday, January 4.** Participation is not mandatory, but is recommended because of the changes to argument protocols and format this Term. Please let Denise McNerney and me know if you plan to participate. We will send out call-in information before the call.


