Mr. Morris:

This responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated 1 June 2022 and received by the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI) on 2 June 2022, in which you sought: *“All messages sent, received, or otherwise posted on the internal U.S. intelligence messaging system eChirp containing any of the following key terms from January 4, 2021, through January 8, 2021.”* Your request then specified 34 specific terms for which to search.

Upon review, we have determined that the records you requested fall outside the scope of the ODNI as the National Security Agency (NSA) serves as the Executive Agent for eChirp records. We suggest resubmitting your request to NSA for proper processing.
