Any emails returned based on that search criteria were then reviewed to determine whether those emails are responsive to your request.

The *Dobbs* Supreme Court case presents the pro-life movement with its biggest opportunity in decades to save lives. In this case, the Court is reconsidering the constitutionality of pre-viability limits on abortion.

The Supreme Court will likely issue its decision in June 2022 during the heat of the midterm elections. Democrats – having little else to run on – will likely seize this issue and try to go on offense. **It is imperative that the GOP be prepared to counter this and brand the Democrats as the real abortion extremists.**

In particular, the memo outlines four key messaging recommendations for candidates and other key allies involved in 2022:

1. **Focus on the humanity of the unborn child at 15 weeks**, especially the child’s developmental features and ability to feel excruciating pain – all proven by modern medicine and science.
2. **Emphasize that the likely outcome in *Dobbs* will be to allow the American people to debate this issue through their elected representatives – NOT a complete nationwide ban on abortion.** Elected officials rather than unelected judges will set abortion policy based on where consensus is found.
3. **Hammer Democrats for their extremist position in favor of abortion on demand**, even painful late-term abortions when the child can feel excruciating pain.
4. **Demonstrate that the pro-life movement cares not only about the unborn child, but about the mother as well**, and provides the resources necessary for her to choose life.

The following document serves as a roadmap to accomplishing this goal and shares further relevant information about this case as we prepare for victory in *Dobbs* – and the midterm elections – in 2022.



***Dobbs* Supreme Court Case: Staying on Offense in 2022**

Background on *Dobbs*: A Monumental Opportunity to Save Lives

The *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization* case being heard by the Supreme Court this term is the biggest opportunity for the pro-life movement to save lives in 30 years since the Court reconsidered *Roe v. Wade* when it heard *Planned Parenthood v. Casey* in 1992.

In *Dobbs*, the Supreme Court is reviewing a Mississippi law that limits abortion after 15 weeks of pregnancy. Even more significantly, the Court will review whether all pre-viability limits on elective abortion are unconstitutional. Viability, the point at which babies not only survive but thrive outside the womb, is now as early as 21 weeks.

Mississippi [argues](#) that it has an interest in limiting abortion after 15 weeks of pregnancy (and prior to viability) based on advances in medical science that have shown:

- The advanced biological development of an unborn baby at 15 weeks, including a beating heart, functioning vital organs, the ability to suck a thumb, and a fully formed nose, lips, eyelids and eyebrows.
- The capability of an unborn baby to feel pain by 15 weeks.
- The increased threat to a mother caused by a surgical abortion taking place after the 15-week mark.

Under *Roe* and *Casey*, the Supreme Court held that the due process clause of the Fourteenth Amendment protects a woman's right to abortion prior to viability, categorically blocking states from protecting unborn children prior to viability. It is possible that with the *Dobbs* case the Court will gut or overturn these precedents and hand the issue back to the people to decide. This would allow citizens to have a say in policies protecting the unborn through the democratic process and their elected officials—both in Congress and in the states.

Impact on the 2022 Elections – Staying on Offense

The *Dobbs* case will likely be decided in June 2022, during the heat of the midterm elections. While the Court could uphold *Roe* and *Casey*, legal experts believe that the current Court, with its new majority of Constitutionalists, could either effectively gut or outright overturn those precedents.

If that were to happen, legislative bodies would have more flexibility to pass laws protecting babies prior to viability, the time at which a baby can survive and thrive outside the womb. It's possible that the Court could narrowly allow Mississippi's 15-week limit to stand. The Court could also go further and

completely overturn *Roe* and *Casey*, allowing states and Congress to pass greater protections for the unborn according to the will of the people.

If the Court upholds the Mississippi law, we can expect pro-abortion Democrats to use abortion as their number one issue going into November, scaremongering that the GOP is trying to take away an alleged fundamental right of women. The GOP and pro-life candidates must be ready to fight back, and most importantly, stay on offense regarding the national consensus that supports limits on abortion.

It seems clear that the political environment is likely to favor the GOP next year. That makes it even more likely that the Democrats will rely heavily on abortion as their narrative. At present, they have nothing else. For that reason, the opportunity to “hide” from the issue in a given race seems highly unlikely.

The best way to stay on offense is to draw a strong contrast between the GOP position on abortion and the Democratic position on abortion.

- **Democratic position:** Abortion should be legal through all nine months of pregnancy, even late-term abortions when the child can feel excruciating pain. Additionally, all abortions, including brutal late-term abortions, should be paid for by taxpayers.
- **GOP position:** In poll after poll ([Marist](#), [NPR](#), [Gallup](#)) the American people have stated that they want restrictions on abortion. Only a very small minority supports what *Roe* allows—abortion available right up to birth. The American people should decide abortion policy and laws through their elected representatives, rather than having these decisions be forced upon us by unelected judges. Let the democratic system work. Congress and states will have this debate and act—or not act—based on where consensus is found. Some states are already poised to protect the unborn from the point at which the heartbeat can be detected, while other states may take more modest approaches. Nationally, there is strong majority support for limiting late-term abortions after 15 weeks of pregnancy when the child can feel excruciating pain, as well as strong consensus against taxpayer funding of abortion.

If the Democrats want to argue that abortion should be legal for any reason right up to the point of birth they are free to do so, but very few voters will stand with them. Almost all of the industrialized world has decided there should be reasonable limits on abortion. Even very liberal France agrees with the Mississippi law.

In a [poll](#) conducted by OnMessage for SBA List, likely 2022 voters were asked whether they are more likely to support a GOP candidate who supports a 15-week limit on abortion versus a Democratic candidate who supports abortion on demand up to birth. 53% of voters chose the GOP candidate; just 28% chose the Democratic candidate. Independents broke 54% to 18% in favor of the GOP candidate.

Impact in the Virginia Governor’s Race

The November 2021 Virginia Governor’s race offers a good preview for how the issue may play out in 2022 races.

Terry McAuliffe spent millions on TV ads featuring abortion – see his spots “[What It Means](#),” “[Far Right Agenda](#),” “[Caught](#),” “[Use Our Power](#),” and “[Our Values](#)” featuring former President Obama. McAuliffe even campaigned at an abortion clinic in the state that performs abortions up to 16 weeks. The issue was in the national spotlight in the final stretch of the race, as Texas’s Heartbeat Act went into effect on September 1st, causing a national stir, and the Supreme Court heard oral arguments on the Act’s unique civil enforcement mechanism the day before the election.

However, Glenn Youngkin did not concede the issue to McAuliffe. Instead, as soon as McAuliffe ran his first attack ad, Youngkin countered with his own spot, “[No Limit](#),” which slammed McAuliffe for supporting abortion on-demand up until birth. Youngkin repeated this message on the campaign trail anytime the issue came up including in the debates.

The result? According to CNN [exit polling](#), 8% of Virginia voters said abortion was the most important issue influencing their vote. Youngkin won this segment of voters 58% to 41%, a 17-point margin.

Four Key Messages

SBA List has conducted extensive polling, message testing, and focus groups. From this research, we extracted four key key messages:

1. Focus on the humanity of the unborn child at 15 weeks, especially the child’s developmental features and ability to feel excruciating pain – all proven by modern medicine and science.

Thanks to advances in modern medicine and science, the humanity of a 15-week-old child in the womb is undeniable. Children at this stage have fully formed noses and lips, eyelids and eyebrows; they can suck their thumbs, and can even feel pain.

2. Emphasize that the likely outcome in *Dobbs* will be to allow the American people to debate this issue through their elected representatives – NOT a complete nationwide ban on abortion. Elected officials rather than unelected judges will set abortion policy based on where consensus is found.

Elected representatives, not unelected judges, should determine abortion policy in America. The pro-life movement is hopeful that the Supreme Court in *Dobbs* will allow democracy to do its job and let the people debate when life should be protected under the law. We are long past due to let legislative bodies update our laws to reflect decades of scientific and technological progress highlighting the humanity of the unborn. Different states and Congress will come to various conclusions based on where consensus is found.

3. Hammer Democrats for their extremist position in favor of abortion on demand, even painful late-term abortions when the child can feel excruciating pain.

Democrats in Washington are completely out of step with the consensus of the American people on the issue of life. Poll after poll shows that a strong majority of Americans want to limit late-term abortions. Yet the modern Democratic Party is so extreme that it supports abortion on demand, up until the moment of birth, paid for by the taxpayer. They hold this position despite the fact that 47 of

50 progressive European nations have limits on abortion in line with Mississippi. Because of *Roe* and *Casey*, the United States is more in line with China and North Korea when it comes to abortion policy.

4. Demonstrate that the pro-life movement cares not only about the unborn child, but about the mother as well, and providing the resources necessary for her to choose life.

The pro-life movement cares not only about the unborn child, but also for vulnerable mothers. This is demonstrated by the more than 2,700 pregnancy care centers nationwide that serve millions of people annually. It is also demonstrated by government-funded programs like the Texas Alternatives to Abortion program – with a \$100 million annual budget – that provides counseling, material assistance, care coordination, and housing support.
