On May 19, 2021, Governor Greg Abbott signed Senate Bill 8, a measure that would prohibit abortions in Texas as early as six weeks. Texas healthcare providers have indicated concerns about the potential effects of the bill.

American Oversight seeks records with the potential to shed light on state health officials' assessments of Senate Bill 8.

In conducting your search, please understand the term "record" in its broadest sense, to include any written, typed, recorded, graphic, printed, or audio material of any kind. We seek records of any kind, including electronic records, audiotapes, videotapes, and photographs, as well as letters, emails, facsimiles, telephone messages, voice mail messages and transcripts, notes, or minutes of any meetings, telephone conversations or discussions. Our request includes any attachments to these records. No category of material should be omitted from search, collection, and production.
