Soldiers on our LP/OPs had 103 migrant detections and two turnbacks (typically criminal individuals who wish to avoid detection) prior to midnight last night. The number of detections has remained unchanged since midnight. Our total confirmed detections is 341, turnbacks is 2, and scouting remains at 2.

The TF has been continuing to make adjustments to improve. The schedule has been altered to give the Soldiers a more consistent schedule. We also adjusted the shift times to avoid rush hour traffic; a previous challenge was traveling during rush hour with the significant road construction. This change also adds a [REDACTED] as a Sergeant of the guard (SOG) and puts a medic with each SOG. We will be implementing the changes tomorrow night.

Our vehicle situation remains in jeopardy. We are currently using one TX rental vehicle. We would likely need to find another solution if the S4 learns of the arrangement. D Co, which our PLT is a part of, and A Co, who supplied our box truck, is facilitating our current resolution. The primary concern from the S4 is liability in event of a collision.

I have been operating out of the S3 shop for the week, inputting data to facilitate trend analysis, and volunteering for tasks as they come up.

I attached the SITREP for 15JUL. Leaders at the tactical level agree we do not have sufficient nontactical vehicles with us. We have one minivan assigned to D Co. which is being used under the radar. The primary concern is if a SD Guardsman were to be involved in a collision in a TX rental. When asked, the consensus was that Texas vehicles should be fueled using Texas fuel cards, so we will work with them if the van needs fuel. There were 103 Illegal Aliens (IAs) detained by BP. The Soldiers observed a couple turnbacks, (typically evidence of criminal activity if the individual does not want to be apprehended by Border Patrol) and one instance of scouting on 15 July. To date, we have 341 confirmed detentions called in to BP.

I attached the SITREP. 125 surrenders. We moved to Zone 1, and it went smoothly. We are currently manning the three LP/OPs concurrently with A Co.

Three of the vehicles will be tied up on mission for longer periods of time. If we end up maintaining our current footprint, and it works out that there are some troops that swap out, I would request/recommend that the troops who come onto the mission drive two state vehicles, to Texas. This would allow us to stop renting the van and provide additional transportation for Soldiers to get supplies. One state vehicle does not routinely return to the hotel, and two are gone for approximately 14.5 hours daily. When I returned to the hotel, there were a couple groups of people who requested keys before I made it back to my room.

See attached TF 153 SITREP and comments below from [REDACTED].

Leaders at the tactical level agree we do not have sufficient nontactical vehicles with us. We have one minivan assigned to D Co. which is being used under the radar. The primary concern is if a SD Guardsman were to be involved in a collision in a TX rental. When asked, the consensus was that Texas vehicles should be fueled using Texas fuel cards, so we will work with them if the van needs fuel. There were 103 Illegal Aliens (IAs) detained by BP. The Soldiers observed a couple turnbacks, (typically evidence of criminal activity if the individual does not want to be apprehended by Border Patrol) and one instance of scouting on 15 July. To date, we have 341 confirmed detentions called in to BP.

ALCON,

The following is information gathered from the CUB this morning.

TF Salerno continues to train the recently arrived 300 PAX and some of them have started to join companies depending on where they fall in the task org. The TF will be conducting another IWQ in the later part of the September as they still have about 140 PAX that are not qualified.

No weather issues as all significant weather has dissipated or moved to other areas.

SIGACTs reported include:

During the early morning hours of 27 AUG, three Cartel del Golfo (CDG) hitmen were reported to have attacked State Police officials in Matamoros, Tamaulipas (35 minutes away on M side). The gunmen reportedly opened fire on State Police, initiating a vehicle chase through the city. The pursuit ended with the officers ramming the suspect

vehicle, causing it to ignite in flames and the cartel members to perish.

The San Diego County Sheriff's Department announced the exposure of one of their officers, Deputy [REDACTED], to the drug Fentanyl. This opioid is considered 50 times more potent than heroin and continues to grow as one of the greatest threats to United States. Texas DPS reports an eight-fold increase in fentanyl seizures along the U.S.-Mexico border when comparing Jan-Apr 2020 and the same time frame in 2021.

On 28 AUG a caravan of more than 600 individuals was stopped by the Mexican National Guard in Tapachula, Mexico. The individuals were said to have grown increasingly frustrated with the delay in immigration proceedings. This caravan is believed to be heading towards the border.

As of 30 AUG, and in response to the tens of thousands of Afghans seeking refuge following the overtaking by the Taliban, Mexican foreign relations Secretary stated that Mexico will "support human rights applications for refuge, asylum and humanitarian visas."

The current number of COVID positive Soldiers for TF Salerno is 23.

There was a slight uptick in the number of encounters on our points but remains low.





Rio Grande Valley Operations Center (RGV OPCEN) has reported divisions between various factions within the CDG. These factions are now in-fighting one another along the US-Mexico border between Reynosa and Miguel Aleman, Tamaulipas (Zones 1-9).

I was informed that TXARNG Major General Norris and [REDACTED] have intentions of traveling to South Dakota in the future, this will correspond with the final approval of Texas awards for TF 153.

TF Salerno will start having weekly press conferences with the media starting 09/16 each Thursday. [REDACTED] is also working on a roll up reference our involvement for the last two months.

During the CUB with TF Salerno today, the topic of the meeting was COVID. The TF leadership reported there are 9 COVID positive SMs in the TF that are all unvaccinated. The TF is coordinating vaccines for any SMs that want to take advantage. During the CUB it was also reported there are several hotels in McAllen that are being filled with COVID positive migrants. The S2 shop was going to follow up on this information but the hotels were not any that house TF Salerno Soldiers.

There are about 300 SMs that are going to be augmenting the mission in the RGV. These augmentations will be affecting other zones and not TF 153's zone. There are also concerns about the incoming tropical storm Marco. The current path is markedly close to our AO. We will continue to monitor as it gets closer. Once again, our medics received accolades from leadership for their actions during the incident with the migrant child a few days ago.

The day on the line was slower today. Soldiers were able turn back 8 people who were attempting to cross.

PAIC [REDACTED] presented our Soldiers with some BP gifts and presented a speech acknowledging their professionalism and swift action. [REDACTED] presented our Soldiers with TF Salerno coins. It was a great presentation that demonstrated the partnership between the TXARNG, the SDARNG and our Law Enforcement partners.

PAIC [REDACTED] stated thanks to the National Guard the Border Patrol can concentrate on stopping drugs that come through the area. He said over \$1 billion dollars are generated due to the drug activity that crosses through the RGV every month by the cartels. He said recently they were able to catch 50 lbs of cocaine, a street value of \$10-\$20 million dollars.

[REDACTED] explained the TF in the RGV had recently added 300 TXARNG Soldiers. They are looking to add another 600 by October and are scheduled to be at 2500 Soldiers strong by the end of December. He mentioned that the Texas legislators had approved on 08/25/2021 \$1.8 billion for the border security mission. The Soldiers had more volume on points today than on the last couple days. We had 124 turn themselves in.

There had been rumors of increased COVID cases among migrants. A couple nights ago, at the ball fields near one of our sites, we heard several migrants were tested for COVID, and they all came back positive. We told the Soldiers to take additional precautions that night, to include keeping their distance.

Yesterday during a briefing to the Governor and TAG, a Border Patrol agent mentioned getting a call about a recent spike in cases. Today, a DPS agent in LaJoya was waved down by a concerned citizen. The citizen relayed there was a family coughing and sneezing inside Whataburger, without covering their mouths, and they were not wearing face coverings. The agent learned they were apprehended by BP days earlier, but released because they had COVID. A local charity got them a room at a local hotel. (This charity booked all the rooms at the hotel in question) They further learned this charity is assisting several families in similar situations get rooms at hotels in McAllen and LaJoya. This is concerning, as we work near LaJoya, and are housed in McAllen. In checking with our hotel, there are NOT any rooms booked under the charity involved in the described incident.

Finally, the area in Mexico just south of the Rio Grande Valley, where we are located is seeing increased positivity rates. I have passed this information down the chain with a reminder for our Soldiers to attempt to keep their distance from the migrants. This latest increase seems to be a trend.

Today, [REDACTED] went on a leader recon to Zones 1-2, near Roma, where we are planning to move in the near future. I was pulled into facilitating an IG visit for the better part of the afternoon. The assistant S3 plans to use me in planning and managing DV visits moving forward. These visits happen regularly.
