RE: Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") Request

Dear Ms. Shaw:

This Office received your FOIA request, which seeks:

1. All email communications (including emails, email attachments, complete email chains, calendar invitations, and calendar invitation attachments) sent by Attorney General Alan Wilson and Chief Deputy Attorney General William Jeffrey Young from May 2, 2022 at 8:30 PM ET through May 3, 2022, and from June 24, 2022 through June 25, 2022.

In an effort to accommodate your office and reduce the number of potentially responsive records to be processed and produced, American Oversight has limited item 1 of its request to emails sent by Attorney General Wilson and Chief Deputy Attorney General Young. To be clear, however, American Oversight still requests that complete email chains be produced, displaying both sent and received messages. This means, for example, that Wilson's response to an email and the initial received message are responsive to this request and should be produced.

2. All text messages or messages on messaging platforms (such as Slack, GChat or Google Hangouts, Lync, Skype, Twitter direct messages, Facebook messages, WhatsApp, Signal, Telegram, or Parler) sent or received by Attorney General Alan Wilson and Chief Deputy Attorney General William Jeffrey Young from May 2, 2022 at 8:30 PM ET through May 3, 2022, and from June 24, 2022 through June 25, 2022.

On September 20, 2022, we determined that there were documents responsive to your request. This determination is made in accordance with S.C. Code Ann. § 30-4-30(C).

The records responsive to your request are attached.

Please be advised that some records are exempt from production pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. § 30-4-40(a)(7).






