Dear Evan Mayanja,

The Wisconsin Elections Commission (“the Commission”) received your public records request on November 30, 2022. You requested communications sent or received by Commissioner Spindell or Chair Millis to any of a specified list of email addresses.

After reviewing the WEC’s records, I have identified records that appear to be responsive to search terms derived from your request.

Records are being withheld under the doctrine of attorney-client privilege. A requestor has a right to inspect any record, "except otherwise provided by law." Wis. Stat. § 19.35(1)(a). The attorney-client privilege protects confidential communications between attorneys and their clients. Wis. Stat. § 905.03. Accordingly, records protected under the doctrine of attorney-client privilege are not subject to disclosure under Wisconsin's open records law. Additionally, records have been partially redacted under the doctrine of attorney-client privilege, but the nonprivileged portions are being released to you.

The file of responsive records is too large to send as an attachment, so I can instead send it to you via this Dropbox link:

The file exists permanently within our internal system. If it is ever removed from our Dropbox, you can always request it from us again at any time.

To the extent that this response denies any part of your public records request, the WEC's determination is subject to review in an action for mandamus under Wis. Stat. § 19.37(1), or by application to a district attorney or the Attorney General.

Dear Commissioners,

The purpose of this expression is to provide injury notice, challenge to, and objection of certification for Wisconsin's August 9th, 2022 Primary for the following reasons, seeking reconciliation of all ballots in order to remedy:

- 1) Please explain the vote total difference between my candidacy for Governor with that of Ms. Mueller's candidacy for Attorney General, given we campaigned together extensively and spoke with common, like-minded citizens of Wisconsin statewide...?
- 2) Concerns with absentee ballots not being verified or secure to proven vulnerabilities within 'myvote'...?
- 3) With common voter support known with regards to a majority of Lt. Governor candidates that I also campaigned with extensively, who collectively garnered nearly 300,000 votes from fellow Patriot, Grassroot, Freedom Fighter, & GOP Co. Party groups, please explain what caused the difference between their collective votes, with my nearly 42,000 votes...?
- 4) I request to see the Cast Vote Records for the Statewide Gubernatorial race from the August 9th, 2022 Primary...?
- 5) Very serious concerns about the 300+ same day voter registrations within the 63rd Assembly District. Has anyone contacted these individuals to ask why they did this, what time of day they performed this task, & if anyone approached them to do so...?
- 6) The Wisconsin voter rolls remain unclean, still listing over 7.1M names when only 4.5M are eligible and 3.5M actually vote. This data file also contains active & inactive within the same data file, and on the same server. Open for fraud, the fact this condition still exists after concerns were expressed in 2020, nullifies the 8/9/2022 WI Primary...?
- 7) On the weekend of August 20th-21st, 2022, algorithms within voting machines, which includes tabulators, was proven. As such, vote suppression & vote manipulation can occur, and in my opinion did statewide. This is most apparent in the Gubernatorial race as well as in the 63rd Assembly race, where highly noted & significant delays in reporting were seen. This obvious obstruction within the [s]elections process leaves no doubt to manipulation of votes, illegal acts that prevents certification of this process...?

These inquiries and requests need comprehensive replies in order to resolve concerns and approval before any next-step requirement(s) are performed. Public trust in the current 'election' process is at an all-time low, and falling. This issue has not and will not get better until truth and transparency exist.

I look forward to your assistance in this matter and ask that you refrain from status quo action of certification until remedy(s) are in place.

Representative Brandtjen,

In accordance with the Wisconsin Elections Commission's July 12, 2022, unanimous directive, the Chair of the Commission will place a discussion of your request on the agenda for the next quarterly meeting of the Commission, which is scheduled for November 30, 2022.

The six-member Commission has previously considered your specialized assistance request and whether it can be fulfilled to both ensure confidentiality and appropriate use of data, and to consider if the request can be accomplished within the agency's existing appropriation. The June 16, 2022, Legislative Counsel memo to your office cites Wis. Stat. § [13.45\(7\)](#), which states, in part, "Upon request by legislative committees, and within the limits of existing appropriations, departments of state government shall supply such specialized staff assistance as a legislative committee may require."

In response to this request and the Legislative Counsel memo, the WEC met to discuss how to proceed with the request. As reflected in the meeting minutes found [here](#) (page 4), the Commission unanimously directed staff to work with your office and legislative counsel to draft a MOU and to then report back to the Commission. Since then, the WEC has worked to address both concerns related to confidentiality and funding in a good-faith effort to fulfill the request. Related to confidentiality concerns, the WEC proposed an MOU to legislative counsel; this approach was not accepted, meaning WEC staff will now need to report back to the Commission to ask for further direction. As it relates to funding necessary to accomplish the request, the six-member Commission has also considered and approved the 2023-2025 biennial budget, which requests an increase of the agency's GPR appropriation to provide assistance to the Legislature in fulfilling complex and timely data requests which are not currently part of our existing appropriation. The full budget proposal and the Commission's vote related to the request to increase the appropriation can be found [here](#).

Following the Commission's November 30, 2022, meeting, we will follow up with any additional directives from the Commission. In the meantime, WEC staff is glad to report that we have been able to expedite all of your open records requests, meeting the timelines you requested and fulfilling your requests, on average, in 5.8 days. WEC is always pleased to answer legislative inquiries and provide open records and information to the Legislature when it can ensure confidentiality/appropriate use and when the request can be fulfilled within the agency's existing appropriations, as required by law.

Representative Brandtjen,

In accordance with the Wisconsin Elections Commission's July 12, 2022, unanimous directive, the Chair of the Commission will place a discussion of your request on the agenda for the next quarterly meeting of the Commission, which is scheduled for November 30, 2022.

The six-member Commission has previously considered your specialized assistance request and whether it can be fulfilled to both ensure confidentiality and appropriate use of data, and to consider if the request can be accomplished within the agency's existing appropriation. The June 16, 2022, Legislative Counsel memo to your office cites Wis. Stat. § [13.45\(7\)](#), which states, in part, "Upon request by legislative committees, and within the limits of existing appropriations, departments of state government shall supply such specialized staff assistance as a legislative committee may require."

In response to this request and the Legislative Counsel memo, the WEC met to discuss how to proceed with the request. As reflected in the meeting minutes found [here](#) (page 4), the Commission unanimously directed staff to work with your office and legislative counsel to draft a MOU and to then report back to the Commission. Since then, the WEC has worked to address both concerns related to confidentiality and funding in a good-faith effort to fulfill the request. Related to confidentiality concerns, the WEC proposed an MOU to legislative counsel; this approach was not accepted, meaning WEC staff will now need to report back to the Commission to ask for further direction. As it relates to funding necessary to accomplish the request, the six-member Commission has also considered and approved the 2023-2025 biennial budget, which requests an increase of the agency's GPR appropriation to provide assistance to the Legislature in fulfilling complex and timely data requests which are not currently part of our existing appropriation. The full budget proposal and the Commission's vote related to the request to increase the appropriation can be found [here](#).

Following the Commission's November 30, 2022, meeting, we will follow up with any additional directives from the Commission. In the meantime, WEC staff is glad to report that we have been able to expedite all of your open records requests, meeting the timelines you requested and fulfilling your requests, on average, in 5.8 days. WEC is always pleased to answer legislative inquiries and provide open records and information to the Legislature when it can ensure confidentiality/appropriate use and when the request can be fulfilled within the agency's existing appropriations, as required by law.

Representative Brandtjen,

In accordance with the Wisconsin Elections Commission's July 12, 2022, unanimous directive, the Chair of the Commission will place a discussion of your request on the agenda for the next quarterly meeting of the Commission, which is scheduled for November 30, 2022.

The six-member Commission has previously considered your specialized assistance request and whether it can be fulfilled to both ensure confidentiality and appropriate use of data, and to consider if the request can be accomplished within the agency's existing appropriation. The June 16, 2022, Legislative Counsel memo to your office cites Wis. Stat. § [13.45\(7\)](#), which states, in part, "Upon request by legislative committees, and within the limits of existing appropriations, departments of state government shall supply such specialized staff assistance as a legislative committee may require."

In response to this request and the Legislative Counsel memo, the WEC met to discuss how to proceed with the request. As reflected in the meeting minutes found [here](#) (page 4), the Commission unanimously directed staff to work with your office and legislative counsel to draft a MOU and to then report back to the Commission. Since then, the WEC has worked to address both concerns related to confidentiality and funding in a good-faith effort to fulfill the request. Related to confidentiality concerns, the WEC proposed an MOU to legislative counsel; this approach was not accepted, meaning WEC staff will now need to report back to the Commission to ask for further direction. As it relates to funding necessary to accomplish the request, the six-member Commission has also considered and approved the 2023-2025 biennial budget, which requests an increase of the agency's GPR appropriation to provide assistance to the Legislature in fulfilling complex and timely data requests which are not currently part of our existing appropriation. The full budget proposal and the Commission's vote related to the request to increase the appropriation can be found [here](#).

Following the Commission's November 30, 2022, meeting, we will follow up with any additional directives from the Commission. In the meantime, WEC staff is glad to report that we have been able to expedite all of your open records requests, meeting the timelines you requested and fulfilling your requests, on average, in 5.8 days. WEC is always pleased to answer legislative inquiries and provide open records and information to the Legislature when it can ensure confidentiality/appropriate use and when the request can be fulfilled within the agency's existing appropriations, as required by law.
