Public Comment Period Opens on Use of Candidate Funds for Residential Property

Raleigh, N.C. – The State Board of Elections has opened the public comment period on the adoption of the rule cited as 08 NCAC 21 .0301. The full text can be found [here](#).

The public comment period ends June 15, 2020.

Bob Hall, a registered voter and resident of Orange County, submitted a rulemaking petition to the State Board of Elections on January 23, 2020, under [G.S. § 150B-20](#) and 08 NCAC 15 .0101.

The petition proposed a prohibition on the use of candidate committee funds to purchase, lease, rent or reimburse the candidate for residential real property that is owned directly or indirectly by the candidate or a member of the candidate's family.

The State Board granted the petition on March 20, 2020, which starts the rulemaking process, including proposing text of the rule and soliciting public comment.

We have concerns over the partisan breakdown and any other screening mechanisms this firm might have been instructed to employ.

Specifically, what guidelines are in force for employing and staffing early voting locations? Who is required to screen for partisan affiliations, citizenship, criminal record, etc.?

Jay DeLancy is Director of VIP-NC, a non-partisan, all-volunteer, organization with a mission to restore trust in the democratic process through analysis, detection and prevention of vote fraud. The group's data analysis techniques have resulted in their discovering almost 30,000 deceased persons on NC's voter rolls (while helping BOE officials prevent similar future errors); finding more than 500 registered voters who later evaded jury duty by claiming to be non-US citizens; and a three-state criminal investigation into 149 cases of suspected interstate-double voting. To date, their research has triggered 17 criminal referrals, three criminal indictments and two felony convictions. Dozens of other cases are awaiting prosecution.

I want to report two absentee ballot problems in one household.

1) A gentleman at my church, Joseph E Ferrell, Jr. received TWO identical absentee ballots in the mail 13 days apart. I researched his voter registration online and it is clear that two ballots were mailed, as you can see below. The second "request" on November 2 is false information as he never mailed another request to the BOE. The second ballot was mailed 13 days after his initial ballot was mailed. His son, Joseph E Ferrell, III also requested an absentee ballot which he already received and returned, that is documented on your website. Unfortunately, your website does not show that his father's ballot has been received by your office even though it was returned at the same time as his son's.

2) Joseph's wife, Sherron Ferrell (who explained all of this to me yesterday), voted early at Green Road but your website shows that she was mailed an absentee ballot. See details below.
