





Starting in 2010, the Bureau of Justice Statistics began reporting citizen prison populations and voting-age populations. I subtract these populations from the prison

statistics. For non-reporting states I estimate the non-citizen felon population from similar adjacent states.

## Use of National Change of Address data as evidence of a move

Public Law 103-31—MAY 20, 1993

(C) VOTE REMOVAL PROGRAMS – A state may meet the requirement of subsection (a)(4) by establishing a program under which--

(A) Change-of-address information supplied by the Postal Service through its licensees is used to identify registrants whose addresses may have changed; and

(B) If it appears from information provided by the Postal Service that--

(i) a registrant has moved to a different residence address in the same registrar's jurisdiction in which the registrant is currently registered, the registrar changes the registration records to show the new address and sends the registrant a notice to show the new address and sends the registrant a notice of the change by forwardable mail and postage prepaid pre-addressed return form by which the registrant may verify or correct the address information; or

(ii) the registrant has moved to a different residence address not in the same registrar's jurisdiction, the registrar uses the notice procedure describe din subsection (d)(2) to confirm the change of address.

## Georgia 2022 Impact


Impact of 2021 deaths only: Extrapolated from the National Death Ratio

When ERIC or anyone tries to match R)chards from the Georgia Voter Roll with Richards from the NCOA or SSI Death Master . *If evenly distributed, 17.8% of the registered voters have errors in their fields which would prevent matching.*

This type error could be prevented if the Georgia SOS adopted the Voter Registration Form that I designed about a year ago, slide 23 is a sample of that form & process.

*Specifically, in the May 2023 data set from the Georgia SOS:  
 43,896 of the voter records had the Last Vote Date as 12/9/21;  
 3,946,210 of the voter records had NO Last Vote Date.*

*This represents an error rate of 50.3%.*

Specifically, the new fields contained in the Voter Roll data available for download has been cut in half. As everyone knows, less data = less accurate assessments. It costs nothing to include the data that was being sold from the old system. I can think of no valid reason for dropping about 30 fields from the new download format. Perhaps you could provide some insight into the reasoning for the SOS removing them from the current downloads?

These errors can be, should be, and should have been corrected.

Now to my question: What does EagleAI NETwork, LLC need to do to be included in the SOS discussions regarding voter roll maintenance between Georgia and other states?

*A simple comparison of Georgia Voter Rolls to the USPS CASS database yields 391,145 Georgia Registered Voters that are registered at an address that the USPS has determined can not receive mail. (147,460 voted 11/8/22)*

When ERIC or anyone tries to match R)chards from the Georgia Voter Roll with Richards from the NCOA or SSI Death Master . *If evenly distributed, 17.8% of the registered voters have errors in their fields which would prevent matching.*

This type error could be prevented if the Georgia SOS adopted the Voter Registration Form that I designed about a year ago, slide 23 is a sample of that form & process.

*Specifically, in the May 2023 data set from the Georgia SOS:  
 43,896 of the voter records had the Last Vote Date as 12/9/21;  
 3,946,210 of the voter records had NO Last Vote Date.*

*This represents an error rate of 50.3%.*

Specifically, the new fields contained in the Voter Roll data available for download has been cut in half. As everyone knows, less data = less accurate assessments. It costs nothing to include the data that was being sold from the old system. I can think of no valid reason for dropping about 30 fields from the new download format. Perhaps you could provide some insight into the reasoning for the SOS removing them from the current downloads?

These errors can be, should be, and should have been corrected.

Now to my question: What does EagleAI NETwork, LLC need to do to be included in the SOS discussions regarding voter roll maintenance between Georgia and other states?
