Re: Request to Inspect Public Records, **R351-353**

Dear Taylor Stoneman,

On March 11, 2024, we received three (3) requests to inspect certain records. Each of these requests were assigned a unique identifying number.



We've run into some mechanical issues with the helicopter we were planning to use for the aerial tour on Monday, instead we will be using 4 separate helicopters that each seat 4 – so each Governor will be on their own helicopter with a pilot who can provide information and explanations while in flight.

For the other 2 seats, wanted to see if you all would be interested in us checking with local TV affiliates if they would provide pool coverage for your stations back home and send a cameraperson in each helicopter. That would leave a final seat for a staffer or security detail.

Please let us know if you all are interested in the pool coverage, and we will begin reaching out to the stations down here ASAP. For Eagle Pass, it's part of the San Antonio media market so we would be contacting WOAI (NBC)/KABB (FOX), KSAT (CBS), and KENS (ABC).

We are also happy to provide one of our videographers/photographers to go up and get content of your Governor, if you would prefer that.

Major General Suelzer provided an update on Texas' and other states' National Guard soldiers' efforts to hold the line, install strategic barriers, and turn back migrants along the Texas-Mexico border. Specifically, Major General Suelzer described soldiers' significance to help push out illegal activity from El Paso by installing 18 miles of concertina wire in the area and noted that turnbacks have gone up 38 percent with the help of other states.

Border Czar Banks thanked the other Governors for their support in Operation Lone Star's border security efforts and reminded them that Texas knows that border security means national security for the rest of the country. He also corrected claims made about Texas' floating marine barriers, explaining their efficacy as deterrents for illegal, unsafe crossings from Mexico into Texas.

Morning y'all!

Here is the info we'd discussed on Friday about food/species being brought in across the border and impacts on ag — our policy team worked with TAHC and other agencies to pull, so there's a lot of info to work with.

Below are descriptions of Texas Animal Health Commission's greatest concerns and what they are doing to address these, as you'll see there are a lot of diseases that are contained or not present in the US, but are endemic to much livestock and animals in Mexico that Texas must monitor to ensure it doesn't enter:

Our greatest concerns are for the potential introductions of devastating and costly animal diseases and pests that can be carried by individuals bringing in raw, smoked, or improperly cooked meat and meat products and wrappings, virus or pest contaminated clothing and other articles, and by crossing diseased or infested live animals. Discarded food, trash, clothing and bedding are regularly found at encampments on ranches where feral swine, cattle, other livestock and wildlife can come in contact with them and any associated disease agent or pest.

Those diseases and pests seen as having the highest potential impact on Texas animals and animal agriculture are:

African Swine Fever (ASF) - a devastating, deadly viral disease that affects swine. ASF is not a threat to human health but is a highly contagious disease of feral and domestic swine that can spread rapidly in swine populations, leading to extremely high rates of death and diseased animals. There is no treatment or vaccine available for this disease. The only way to stop this disease is to depopulate all affected or exposed swine herds, with the presence of feral swine

making this extremely difficult. The ASF virus can survive for months in pork and pork products. ASF is found in countries around the world, and has spread through China, Mongolia and Vietnam, as well as within parts of the European Union. More recently, it has spread to the Dominican Republic and Haiti, alarming close to the continental US. While ASF has never been found in the United States, it could easily be unintentionally brought in by travelers and products from affected countries. Impacts would include potentially heavy loss of swine due to the disease itself and to control measures, and loss of pork exports.

TAHC's ongoing response to the issue: The TAHC, cooperatively with the United States Department of Agriculture, Animal Plant Health Inspection Service, Veterinary Services (USDA APHIS VS), conducts surveillance for ASF and Classical Swine Fever (another disease of concern) by collecting and testing samples collected from swine at livestock markets, and from swine in at-risk herds identified by the agency's risk analysis process. Early detection is key to control and rapid eradication, thereby mitigating effects of a disease outbreak. Agency management has also urged USDA APHIS Wildlife Services to conduct surveillance testing of feral swine inhabiting the area of immigrant encampments, again with the goal of early detection and eradication in mind. The TAHC also conducts producer and veterinary awareness campaigns to increase awareness of the signs of ASF, and let the public know the agency provides a 24-hour hotline for reporting animal disease concerns directly to the on-call TAHC or USDA veterinarian. That number is 800-550-8242.

Foot-and-mouth Disease (FMD) - a severe and highly contagious viral disease that affects cows, pigs, sheep, goats, deer, and other animals with divided hooves. It does not affect horses, dogs, or cats, and is not a public health or food safety threat. The virus survives in living tissue and in the breath, saliva, urine, and other excretions of infected animals. It can survive in raw, smoked, and improperly cooked meat. It can also survive in contaminated materials and the environment for several months under the right conditions. FMD is a worldwide concern, with ongoing outbreaks in several countries in South America, again alarmingly close to the US. The United States eradicated the disease here in 1929, but it could easily be re-introduced by travelers and contaminated products from affected countries. FMD causes production losses and hardships for farmers and ranchers. It also has serious impacts on livestock trade—a single detection of FMD will likely stop international trade completely for a period of time.

TAHC's ongoing response to the issue: The TAHC, together with industry, other states, and the USDA has developed and frequently exercises disease response plans to be activated in a serious disease outbreak, as FMD would definitely qualify. Just one case of FMD in the nation would trigger an emergency disease response. Plans call for stamping out the disease early on through depopulation, but also transitions, should the outbreak expand, into utilization of vaccine from the Strategic National Veterinary Stockpile. The TAHC also has an ongoing awareness campaign as described above for ASF.

Cattle Fever Ticks (CFT) – two species of ticks present in Mexico and in current outbreak areas in south Texas are the only known north American vectors of Bovine babesiosis (cattle

fever), a protozoal disease that can cause up to 90% mortality in cattle that haven't acquired immunity. The fever tick eradication program was started in 1906 and today CFT are somewhat confined to a permanent quarantine zone that runs from Brownsville to Del Rio, Texas along the Mexican border. USDA's mounted tick patrols (tick riders) help to apprehend and treat stray animals that may wander from Mexico. The Cattle Fever Tick Eradication Program is a partnership between USDA and the Texas Animal Health Commission to systematically detect, treat, and eradicate tick infestations. This process is resource intensive, and costly to ranchers and landowners caught up in CFT outbreaks. The CFT can be dispersed by movement of infested livestock and horses, by certain wildlife species, and by movement of infested bedding, hay, and equipment. CFT can be spread to new areas in Texas and other states through the movement of infested clothing and bedding, and by infested pack animals. This would lead to establishment of new CFT quarantine areas and implementations of procedures to eradicate ticks, and would come at a cost to producers, landowners, and state and federal regulatory agencies.

TAHC's ongoing response to the issue: The TAHC utilizes approximately 35 FTEs in the day-to-day CFT eradication program, with the capacity to reassign additional personnel should the need arise in an outbreak situation. The agency maintains portable spray boxes for the treatment of cattle where dipping vats are not available, which would be the case in responding to an outbreak away from the border area with Mexico. The TAHC also utilizes state and federal resources to provide voluntary surveillance and treatment services for buyers of south Texas cattle at six livestock markets. This encourages market interest in south Texas cattle as it assures buyers the cattle will not be caught up in a trace should ticks later be discovered in the herd of origin. Just as important, this service provides surveillance for CFT that would not exist through other means. In the past three years, this voluntary effort has led to the discovery of more than 12 CFT infested herds that would have remained undetected for an undetermined amount of time.

Another concern is over outbreaks caused by diseases carried by cattle and horses that cross the border as strays or are smuggled into Texas:

Bovine brucellosis is controlled in Texas but it is still endemic in Mexico. It can spread from herd to herd and lead to poor fertility, lower milk output, and arthritic joints in cattle. Brucellosis can also infect humans. When discovered, all infected cattle are quarantined, and movement is restricted to slaughter only.

Bovine tuberculosis is also prevalent in many Mexican states. TB is a contagious, chronic, respiratory disease caused by the bacterium *Mycobacterium bovis* (*M. bovis*). This strain of TB can also affect other species of animals including elk, deer, bison, goats, swine, and cats. Sheep and horses are rarely affected. Tuberculosis can affect humans. TB has a long incubation period (months to years) and was once the most prevalent infectious disease of cattle and swine in the United States. Through a cooperative state-federal program, bovine

tuberculosis has been nearly eradicated from livestock in the US. Texas has been declared free of TB, but constant vigilance is crucial to maintaining that TB-free status.

Equine Piroplasmiasis (EP) is a blood-borne protozoal disease that affects horses, donkeys, mules, and zebras. We have managed to control this disease in Texas through surveillance efforts. Horses entering Texas legally from an international border crossing or port screened for EP.

Equine infectious anemia (EIA) is an incurable, infectious disease caused by a virus that can affect horses, donkeys, asses and other equine. This virus destroys red blood cells and is spread through blood-to-blood contact, not through close proximity or casual contact. The virus can be transmitted from an infected equine to a "clean" equine by biting flies, the use of unsterilized or contaminated medical instruments, or through a blood transfusion. Like Equine Piroplasmiasis, horses entering Texas legally from an international border crossing or port are screened for EIA.

There are other disease concerns, such as Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI), but this covers most of the major ones. Please let us know if you need additional information or have any questions.
