Pursuant to the Texas Public Information Act, as codified at Tex. Gov't Code ch. 552, American Oversight makes the following request for public records.

Requested Records

American Oversight requests that the Gillespie County Elections Department promptly produce the following:

All email communications (including emails, complete email chains, calendar invitations, and attachments thereto) sent by Elections Administrator Jim Riley—or anyone communicating on their behalf, such as an assistant, scheduler, or secretary—and containing any of the following key terms.

Fee Waiver Request

In accordance with Tex. Gov't Code § 552.267(a), American Oversight requests a waiver of fees associated with processing this request for records, because such a waiver “is in the public interest because providing the copy of the information primarily benefits the general public.” The requested records are directly related to the work of local officials, with the potential to shed light on how officials tasked with the administration of elections are handling the public inspection of election records. This matter is a subject of substantial public interest in Texas,² and release of any responsive records may help the public understand the operations and activities of state officials and is therefore in the public interest.

Release of the requested records will primarily benefit the public.³ As a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, American Oversight does not have a commercial purpose and the release of the requested records is not in American Oversight's financial interest but is rather in the public interest. American Oversight is committed to transparency and makes the responses governmental authorities provide to public records requests publicly available. As noted, the subject of this request is a matter of public interest, and the public would benefit from an enhanced understanding of the government's activities through American Oversight's analysis and publication of these records. American Oversight's mission is to promote transparency in government, to educate the public about government activities, and to ensure the accountability of government officials. American Oversight uses the information gathered, and its analysis of it, to educate the public through reports, press releases, or other media. American Oversight also makes materials it gathers available on its public website and promotes their availability on social media platforms, such as Facebook and Twitter.com.⁴

American Oversight has also demonstrated its commitment to the public disclosure of documents and creation of editorial content through numerous substantive analyses posted to its website.⁵ Examples reflecting this commitment to the public disclosure of documents and the creation of editorial content include the posting of records related to the organization's investigations into misconduct and corruption in state

governments;⁶ the posting of records related to the Trump Administration's contacts with Ukraine and analyses of those contacts;⁷ posting records and editorial content about the federal government's response to the Coronavirus pandemic;⁸ posting records received as part of American Oversight's "Audit the Wall" project to gather and analyze information related to the administration's proposed construction of a barrier along the U.S.-Mexico border, and analyses of what those records reveal;⁹ the posting of records related to an ethics waiver received by a senior Department of Justice attorney and an analysis of what those records demonstrated regarding the Department's process for issuing such waivers;¹⁰ and posting records and analysis of federal officials' use of taxpayer dollars to charter private aircraft or use government planes for unofficial business.¹¹

Accordingly, American Oversight qualifies for a fee waiver. If your office denies our request for a fee waiver, please notify American Oversight of any anticipated fees or costs in excess of \$40 prior to incurring such costs or fees.

2. All records reflecting requests to inspect voted ballots or any other election records, including, but not limited to, requests for election records under the Texas Public Information Act, or any other formal or informal inquiries into gaining access to a voted ballot or election record.

For both parts of this request, please provide all responsive records from September 1, 2023, through the date the search is conducted.

American Oversight seeks all responsive records regardless of format, medium, or physical characteristics. In conducting your search, please understand the term “record” in its broadest sense, to include any written, typed, recorded, graphic, printed, or audio material. Good morning! I have a few requests that are really non-negotiables. I have attached the law that I am basing most of these request on, but one is because I believe it is the best process.

127.1232 (a) states that Jim SHALL post a licensed peace officer to ensure the security of the ballots throughout tabulation. Therefore, I would like for an officer to come over with the ballots, remain at the Edge with the ballots and take the ballots back to the election's office. Of course this does not have to be the same person but there does need to be an officer inside with the ballots the entire time.

I know that Bruce has provided an officer for us outside. This officer will provided a list of people that can come into the building. (List will have full name, approximate time they are arriving and what job they are doing. If they are a poll watcher, they will be directed to Lori.) If they are not on list they are NOT TO BE PERMITTED INTO BLDG. The officer is to contact me and I will decide if that person can come in by written permission. I will dream up the form for this later.

I am not quite sure who needs to be in this discussion but it is regarding the video recording Bill has been talking about since the first day I met him at St. Joseph's Hall. 127.1232(c) requires (SHALL) that the video recording be livestreamed for the public. Do we still go with the video of this process? If YES, I must be provided with evidence that this can be done by next Friday, March 1, 2024 at 1:00pm. (List will have full name, approximate time they are arriving and what job they are doing. If they are a poll watcher, they will be directed to Lori.) If they are not on list they are NOT TO BE PERMITTED INTO BLDG. The officer is to contact me and I will decide if that person can come in by written permission. I will dream up the form for this later.

I am not quite sure who needs to be in this discussion but it is regarding the video recording Bill has been talking about since the first day I met him at St. Joseph's Hall. 127.1232(c) requires (SHALL) that the video recording be livestreamed for the public.
