

SPEAKING AT THE MARCH FOR LIFE: TIPS & GUIDELINES

Thank you for agreeing to speak at the 2024 Arizona March for Life Rally on March 1, 2024! We are so grateful and want to do everything possible to help you have the most fruitful impact possible. Basic suggestions and tips for successful speaking at the Arizona March for Life Rally are outlined below.

- ❖ **Audience** – The March for Life Rally audience consists of thousands of pro-life people who are gathering to be inspired, learn something new and be motivated to keep working throughout the year in their communities to further the cause of the pro-life movement. We have marchers of all ages, with our largest contingent being young people under 30. Many are first time Marchers, and a few come along to check things out; they might not consider themselves pro-life - this is a great opportunity to speak to them too!
- ❖ **Media**- The Rally will be recorded and posted on our March for Life website, March for Life YouTube, and possibly local news outlets. There will likely be members of the media in front of the stage with cameras. Please know that your March for Life Rally remarks can be quoted widely in the media.
- ❖ **Timing** – Rally speeches should be no longer than 5 minutes in length, unless indicated otherwise. The March for Life Rally is a total of 1 hour in length, with several other speakers joining the program. To allow speakers their opportunity to share their pro-life testimony, staying within the 5 minutes allotted is imperative. To assist with staying within the 5 minutes, we will be providing the following as aids:
 - We will have our Stage Manager side stage giving a signal when time is up.
 - If you go over 5 minutes, we will have the MC walk towards you as a signal and to ease the transition.
- ❖ **Printed Remarks** - We recommend that you bring your printed remarks with you to the rally.
- ❖ **Nonpartisan**- The March for Life and the Arizona Life Coalition are 501(c)(3) tax-exempt organizations. The mission of the March for Life is to end abortion by uniting, educating, and mobilizing pro-life people in the public square, advance respect for the sanctity of human life, and to promote the protection of all innocent human life from conception/fertilization.
 - As the March for Life expands its fight to defend the dignity of human life into states across the country, we are under increased scrutiny by pro-abortion politicians and activists. As such we ask that all speakers keep their topics and speeches focused on pro-life issues, and **nonpartisan in nature**.
 - For the content of your remarks, we'd ask that you observe MFL's 501(c)(3) status and other AZ specific policies, and **please do not advocate for the election or defeat of any candidate for public office, or any ballot measure or policy being introduced or deliberated**. We would be happy to review your remarks in advance to ensure they are in compliance with this guidance.
- ❖ **March for Life Rally Theme** -
 - The theme for the 2024 March for Life is "Pro-Life: For Every Woman, With Every Child". We started the march over 50 years ago with a destination in mind: a post-*Roe* America. With *Roe* behind us following the *Dobbs* decision, the states are now critical battlegrounds for life as we seek new opportunities to protect the unborn, which is why the Arizona March for Life is critically important!
 - We invite you to share remarks pertaining to your experience and leadership in Arizona as it relates to this theme, "With Every Woman, For Every Child", to educate and inspire marchers on how we can continue building a culture of life in Arizona.
