My [REDACTED] son is a senior at Broad Run High School. He wants to major in Criminology and he wants to do his Capstone project at the Loudoun Commonwealth Attorney's office. He sent over all of his information weeks ago and he has called over there. I have called over there as well.

They said that he would hear on the phone this week from them, but he did not. I've been trying to contact someone with the Republican party to assist with this. I helped Bob Anderson be elected as long as many other Republicans on the ballot.

My son did his Eagle Scout project at General George Marshall's historic home and he has been an active Loudoun County 4-H member from elementary through 9th grade. He has helped with several Eagle Scout projects at historic sites in Loudoun County and he has collected food for Scouting for Food since he was three years old. He has been Captain of his Wrestling team, and he has played Varsity Football. He was a Cadet in the Leesburg Civil Air Patrol and he has his Student Pilot license plus American Red Cross CPR and First Aid and Stop the Bleed certifications. He has worked paid part time jobs as well while taking advanced courses in high school. He can bench press 350 pounds and he won the pull up challenge from the Marine recruiters at his high school. He has studied various forms of martial arts.

I don't want my son's Capstone project to fall through because he can't meet his school's deadline because people who I helped get elected are not giving us the time of day. This is not how one treats constituents.

Considering my home state of Wisconsin is the birthplace of the GOP, this is not how the Republican party is supposed to act. It was established in a humble and small one room school house in the quiet town of Ripon by regular Americans.
