In reply to the request set out below, please see the Keller ISD's response below.

American Oversight requests that your office promptly produce the following:

1. All records reflecting any review of curriculum materials for concepts prohibited by HB 3979 or SB 3, conducted either by your office or provided to your office by any other entity or individual. Responsive records include affected course materials, documents reflecting changes to course materials, communications regarding such changes, memoranda, and any other documents pertaining to review of curriculum materials.
2. Records sufficient to identify any changes made or proposed by your office to any curriculum materials to address concepts prohibited by HB 3979 or SB 3.
3. Records sufficient to identify any completed investigations, either conducted by your agency or in your agency's possession, into any individual for using educational materials containing concepts prohibited by HB 3979 or SB 3.

For all parts of this request, please provide all responsive records from August 1, 2022, to the date the search is conducted.

The District has no responsive records "reflecting any review of curriculum materials for concepts prohibited by HB 3979 or SB 3, conducted either by your office or provided to your office by any other entity or individual. Responsive records include affected course materials, documents reflecting changes to course materials, communications regarding such changes, memoranda, and any other documents pertaining to review of curriculum materials."

The District has no responsive records identifying "any changes made or proposed by your office to any curriculum materials to address concepts prohibited by HB 3979 or SB 3."

The District has no responsive records "sufficient to identify any completed investigations, either conducted by your agency or in your agency's possession, into any individual for using educational materials containing concepts prohibited by HB 3979 or SB 3."

The District's ELA curriculum was adopted prior to passage of HB3979 or SB3.

Section 552.275 of the Texas Government Code authorizes a governmental body to establish a reasonable limit, not less than 15 hours for a one month period or 36 hours in a 12 month period, on the amount of time that personnel are required to spend producing public information for inspection or copies to a requestor, without recovering the costs attributable to the personnel time related to that requestor. Section 552.275 does not replace or supersede other sections, and it does not preclude a governmental body from charging labor

supersede other sections, and it does not preclude a governmental body from charging labor for a request for inspection or copies for which a charge is authorized under other sections of this law.

Keller ISD has established 15 hours in a one-month period and 36 hours per 12-month period as the reasonable limit on the amount of time personnel are required to spend producing public information for inspection or copies without recovering attributable costs. This 12-month period coincides with the District's fiscal year, which begins on July 1. Requestors who exceed the 36-hour time limit in a fiscal year (or 15 hours in one month) shall pay all costs attributable to cost of materials, personnel time, and overhead expenses necessary to comply with the request, even if the requestor intends to only inspect the documents. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year thus far, the District has spent 0.25 hour(s) responding to requests you have submitted to date (since July 1, 2023) and provided you with the records gathered and compiled as a result.
