Re: Public Records Law Request

Dear Public Records Officer:

Pursuant to Wisconsin's public records law, Wis. Stat. §§ 19.31-19.39, American Oversight makes the following request for copies of records.

Requested Records

American Oversight requests that your office produce the following records "as soon as practicable and without delay":<sup>1</sup>

- 1. Records sufficient to identify the names and party affiliations of the members of the 2024 County Board of Canvassers
- 2. Records sufficient to determine how each member of the 2024 County Board of Canvassers was selected (e.g., from a list submitted by a political party county committee)
- All notices of meetings of the County Board of Canvassers for the November 2020, November 2022, April 2023, and August 2024 elections ✓
- Records sufficient to identify where and when the meeting notices identified in part 3 of this request were posted.

Fee Waiver Request

In accordance with Wis. Stat. § 19.35(3)(e), American Oversight respectfully requests that the records be produced without charge. Providing American Oversight with a waiver of fees is in the "public interest" because American Oversight will, in accordance with its organizational mission, make the records available to the public without charge. These disclosures will likely contribute to a better understanding of relevant government procedures by the general public.

American Oversight's work is aimed solely at serving the public interest. As a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, American Oversight does not have a commercial purpose and the release of

the information requested is not in American Oversight's financial interest. Rather, American Oversight's mission is to serve the public by promoting transparency in government, educating the public about government activities, and ensuring the accountability of government officials. American Oversight uses the information gathered, and its analysis of it, to educate the public through reports, press releases, or other media.<sup>2</sup> American Oversight also makes materials it gathers available on its public website<sup>3</sup> and promotes their availability on social media platforms, such as Facebook and X (formerly Twitter).<sup>4</sup>

The public has a significant interest in the County Board of Canvassers. Records with the potential to shed light on this matter would contribute significantly to public understanding of operations of the government, including the names and party affiliations of the Board of Canvassers. American Oversight is committed to transparency and makes the responses agencies provide to public records requests publicly available, and the public's understanding of the government's activities would be enhanced through American Oversight's analysis and publication of these records.

American Oversight asks that if its request for a fee waiver is denied in whole or in part, that you contact us prior to incurring any costs.

#### Guidance Regarding the Search & Processing of Requested Records

In the event some portions of the requested records are properly exempt from disclosure, please disclose any reasonably segregable non-exempt portions of the requested records.<sup>5</sup> If it is your position that a document contains non-exempt segments, but that those non-exempt segments are so dispersed throughout the document as to make segregation impossible, please state what portion of the document is non-exempt, and how the material is dispersed throughout the document. If a request is denied in whole, please state specifically that it is not reasonable to segregate portions of the record for release.

Please take appropriate steps to ensure that records responsive to this request are not deleted by the agency before the completion of processing for this request. If records
