Thank you for writing to the County of Franklin with your request for information pursuant to the Pennsylvania Right To Know law.

On October 22, 2024, I received your Right to Know request.

On October 29, 2024, I wrote to advise you that the County was reserving thirty (30) days to permit me time to gather the information and/or documents that would satisfy your request. As a result, the new due date would be November 27, 2024.

Your request is granted in part and denied in part as follows:

The County of Franklin has denied records that are exempt pursuant to Section 708(b)(10)(i)(A) of the Right to Know Law.

You have a right to appeal this denial of information in writing to the Executive Director, Office of Open Records, 333 Market Street, 16th Floor, Harrisburg, PA 17126-0333.

If you choose to file an appeal you must do so within 15 business days of the mailing date of the County's response per Section 1101 of Act 3 of 2008. 



This usually means that the information on the application does not exactly match what is on file with PennDOT or sometimes there is an issue with the interface between the online application process and PennDOT. You will be receiving a Missing Signature letter in the mail. As long as you sign that letter and return it to our office by October 29 you will be registered to vote.
