This email seeks to narrow or clarify your request to avoid the production of and potential charges for responsive information that you are not interested in receiving. Additionally, clarifying or narrowing the scope of your public information request can assist the OOG in providing responsive information to you more quickly and potentially avoid the need for a decision from the Office of the Attorney General.

Your request seeks email metadata for all emails sent by Governor Abbott's government email accounts. Please respond to the following request for clarification or narrowing:

- We note the OOG has received previous requests for similar information, and has released redacted information in response to those requests. However, in those cases, the requestors excluded security information, competitive information, and policy-making and attorney-client privileged information so the OOG was able to redact that information without requesting a ruling from the OAG. **For the schedules that have not been previously released with redactions, are you willing to narrow your request to exclude, policy-making information, attorney-client privileged information, security information, and information related to competitive matters from your request?** If so, the OOG will redact such information and release the remaining information to you.

Your narrowing or clarification of this request does not preclude you from making future requests for additional information. After we receive your response, we can begin a search of our records for the information you are seeking. If the OOG does not receive a response from you by the 61st day after the date this email is sent, your request will be considered withdrawn. See Gov't Code § 552.222(d), (g). The withdrawal of your request does not preclude you from requesting the same or other information in the future.
