Dear President Trump,

I am writing to formally invite you to attend and participate in our upcoming press conference on border security and the construction of a new section of the Texas Border Wall in Rio Grande City, Texas, on December 4th, 2024. I would be honored if you would deliver some remarks as we install the first section of the wall. This would allow the entire nation to understand the measures Texas has taken over the last four years to secure our border. Your presence would send a strong message to the people of Texas that under President Donald J. Trump, the responsibility to secure our border will no longer fall solely upon Texans.

As Land Commissioner, I recently acquired a 1,402-acre ranch along the border near Rio Grande City. Her actions enabled cartel members and violent criminals to sexually abuse migrant women and children on this land for some time.

Since entering this office, at my direction, the General Land Office (GLO) has won several significant victories in the fight to repel cartel activities along our border. Early last year, my office was able to survey several islands in the Rio Grande River and declare them part of the State of Texas, permitting law enforcement to end all human trafficking and drug smuggling operations on them. The largest of these islands is 170 acres, and before declaring it part of Texas, it had been used as a “no-man’s land” to evade both American and Mexican law enforcement. The island, known as “Fronton Island,” had been deemed by the Texas Military Department (TMD) and Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) as the most dangerous part of the Texas border. Cartel-on-cartel violence broke-out almost nightly across the river, including massive firefights with automatic weapons and grenades. The initiative to secure the island, clear it of all brush and vegetation, and install razor wire along the river was named *Operation Flat Top*. During the

operation, evidence of trafficking was found, along with weapon caches and even improvised explosive devices (IEDs). *Operation Flat Top* has been a massive success, as all cartel-related activity has dropped to zero since its completion.

Thanks to your leadership and vision for a safer America, Texas will be able to, once again, count on a federal government that prioritizes national security and the elimination of cartel activity along our southern border. After four years of lawlessness and Americans suffering, we will once again have a President who will put America First!

Please let me know if I can answer any questions you may have before the event. Our nation's future is bright, and together we will make America safe, strong, successful, and great again.

Thank you for considering my request. I look forward to hearing from you.

May God bless you, and may God continue to bless the United States of America.

President Biden is planning executive action that would allow him to shut down the US-Mexico border once the number of migrant crossings reaches 4,000 per day, a source close to the White House told The Post Wednesday.

The order would match a provision in the bipartisan border bill that failed to pass the Senate in February, which gave the president authority to expel migrants when border crossings reached the same daily average.

The legislative proposal would have given the homeland security secretary discretionary authority to carry out removals — but would have made deportations mandatory when illegal entries surpassed 5,000 per day over a one-week period.

The bill allowed for the suspension of that authority two weeks after the seven-day average falls to 75% of those levels.

Maria Bartiromo

Maria Bartiromo joined FOX Business Network (FBN) as Global Markets Editor in January 2014. She is the anchor of *Mornings with Maria* on FBN (6-9 AM/ET), which is the number one pre-market business news program in cable, and anchors *Sunday Morning Futures* (10 AM/ET) on FOX News Channel (FNC), which routinely ranks as the highest rated show on Sundays in cable

news. In April 2017, Bartiromo was also named the anchor for FBN's weekly primetime investing program *Maria Bartiromo's Wall Street* (Fridays, 7 PM/ET).

During her tenure with FBN, Bartiromo has interviewed some of the most prominent leaders in business and economic policy including former President Donald Trump, exiled Crown Prince of Iran Reza Pahlavi, Hong Kong entrepreneur Jimmy Lai, WalMart CEO Doug McMillon, JPMorgan CEO Jamie Dimon, IBM CEO Ginni Rometty, Oracle CEO Mark Hurd, Bridgewater Associates Founder Ray Dalio, Salesforce Founder and CEO Marc Benioff, Microsoft Founder Bill Gates and Treasury Secretary Steven Mnuchin, among others. Bartiromo has written weekly columns for *Business Week* and *Milano Finanza* magazines; as well as monthly columns for *USA Today*, and *Individual Investor*, *Ticker* and *Reader's Digest* magazines. She has also been published in the *Financial Times*, *Newsweek*, *Town and Country*, *Registered Rep* and the *New York Post*.

Bartiromo is a member of the Board of Trustees of New York University, the Council on Foreign Relations, and the Board of Directors of The National Italian American Foundation (NIAF).

She graduated from New York University, where she studied journalism and economics. She also served as an adjunct professor at NYU Stern School of Business for the fall semesters of 2010 through 2013.
