Dear Elizabeth Haddix:

This letter is the final response for your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request submitted to the U.S. General Services Administration's (GSA) FOIA Requester Service Center on December 19, 2024. Your request number is 2025-FOI-00421.

Your request seeks all email communications (including emails, complete email chains, email attachments, calendar invitations, and calendar invitation attachments) between (a) any of the U.S. General Services Administration (GSA) officials listed below, and (b) anyone communicating on behalf of The Trump Organization or the Trump Vance Inaugural Committee (including, but not limited to, anyone communicating from an email address ending in trump.com or t47inaugural.com).

For part 1 of this request, please provide all responsive records from August 1, 2024, through the date the search is conducted.

2. Records reflecting contributions made to the Trump Vance Inaugural Committee, including, but not limited to, names of contributors and amounts contributed.

Regarding item #1, the records you seek are attached and consist of 2 total pages, 2 pages released in part. The exemption used to withhold information from the pages responsive to your request is indicated on the page and listed below for your reference.

GSA has withheld information pursuant to:

Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6), protects information about individuals in “personnel and medical files and similar files” when the disclosure of such information “would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.” Here, the named individuals have a cognizable privacy interest that is not outweighed by the public’s interest.

Regarding item #2, GSA did not locate records responsive to your request. GSA is not privy to any contributions made to the Presidential Inaugural Committee (PIC). The PIC is staffed by Trump-Vance Transition Team (TVTT) representatives with their own IT infrastructure. The TVTT is not required by the Presidential Transition Act (PTA) to publicly disclose transition-related contributions and donors (Section 6) since they did not accept services and funds outlined in Sections 3 and 7 of the PTA.

GSA has considered the foreseeable harm standard, which was codified by the FOIA Improvement Act of 2016, and the Attorney General’s guidance, when processing these records.

Your appeal must be postmarked or electronically transmitted within 90 days of the date of the response to your request. In addition, your correspondence must contain a brief statement regarding the basis of your appeal. Please enclose a copy of your initial request and this response letter. Both the appeal letter and envelope or online appeal submission should be prominently marked, “Freedom of Information Act Appeal.”
