Good Afternoon Team Members,

A couple of operational updates I wanted to share with you all.

To begin, Last Thursday night, The Arizona Attorney General's Office on my behalf filed a "Motion to Intervene" to ensure we have a voice in the Jail District Tax. The unknowns and discussions by our BOS have created the need for me to intervene on your behalf, our citizens, and the inmates in support of the Jail District, specifically for those that voted in favor of the Jail District and my authority to operate and maintain a jail. To refresh a thought, the community survey that was conducted prior to the Jail District election resulted in 3 priorities:

Officer/Inmate Safety
Mental Health
Quality of Life (citizens)

I want to ensure these 3-priorities are shared during a judicial review. A recent meeting with my executive team where we discussed our options. Overwhelmingly, your leadership united for you and the mandates and expectations of this office. Together, we will do what's legally and ethically right for our team members and the citizens we serve! I will keep you posted as this progresses.

Secondly, Sergeant Carl Larimer and I attended an Operational Brief with HSI this morning. They have been directed and deployed throughout Cochise County to assist local law enforcement reference border related investigations and access criminal targets that pose a threat to community and national security. I will yield to Sergeant Larimer to send out additional operational details as he will be the point for these investigations.

Finally, its refreshing to have our federal partners back doing the job that many of us have stepped up to do in their absence. Though, our roles will continue in support of our border security operations, the hope is the federal government will be the primary as we become the secondary for these types of crimes.
