An appeal must be received within 90 calendar days from the date of this letter. The appeal must be in writing. You must include a copy of your original request, this letter, and a statement of the reasons why the information should be made available and why this initial denial is in error. If you submit your appeal by mail, both the letter and the envelope must be clearly marked “Freedom of Information Appeal.”
