The General Assembly "recognizes that while all government agency records are public records for the purpose of their management, not all these records are required to be open to public access, as defined in this chapter, some being exempt under KRS 61.878." KRS 61.8715. . Scheduling items are "nothing more than a draft of what may or may never take place." *Courier-Journal and Louisville Times Co. v. Jones*, 895 S.W.2d 6 (Ky.App. 1995). Calendar appointments of constitutional officers are exempt from inspection. 05-ORD-018; 16-ORD-039; 20-ORD-147. Under KRS 61.878, information of a personal nature has been redacted.
