Dear David Kronig:

This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request made on January 30, 2025, to the U.S. Office of Personnel Management (OPM) Office of the Inspector General (OIG) seeking the following:

“All records reflecting communications (including emails, email attachments, text messages, messages on messaging platforms (such as Signal, Slack, GChat or Google Hangouts, Lync, Skype, or WhatsApp), telephone call logs, calendar invitations, calendar entries, meeting notices, meeting agendas, informational material, draft legislation, talking points, any handwritten or electronic notes taken during any oral communications, summaries of any oral communications, or other materials) between (a) Inspector General Krista Boyd or anyone communicating on their behalf and (b) anyone in the White House Office (including email address communications with email addresses ending in @who.eop.gov and phone logs reflecting calls with numbers beginning (202)456-xxxx).

Please provide all responsive records from January 20, 2025, through January 25, 2025.”

Your request was processed, and a search was conducted under FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552(a) by OPM OIG. After conducting a search, no records responsive to your request were located.

For your information, Congress excluded three discrete categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of FOIA. *See* 5 U.S.C. § 552(c). This response is limited to those records that are subject to the requirements of FOIA. This is a standard notification that is given to all our requesters and should not be taken as an indication that excluded records do, or do not, exist.
